

### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is in Certify, That LOUIS MALE (For Geo. Male)

of Pilot Rock State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of BIRCH Creek, a tributary of the UmatillaRiver,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 115 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Figure BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 7, at page 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1867 for 6 acres and 1908 for 109 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed 1.44 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 25 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeas

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3948

On April 27, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Franklin Hoeft for approval of an additional point of diversion from Birch Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 2579, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Louis Male, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second from Birch Creek for irrigation of 20.0 acres in SW14 NE14, 6.0 acres in NE14 NW14 and 5.0 acres in SE14 NW14 of Section 27, Township 1 North, Range 32 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1908.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 50 feet North and 475 feet East from the South Quarter Corner of Section 27, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 27, Township 1 North, Range 32 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to establish an additional point of diversion, without loss of priority, at a point located 1630 feet South and 260 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of said Section 27, being within the SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 27, Township 1 North, Range 32 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the East Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Umatilla County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 31; June 7 and 14, 1978.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not

exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the additional point of diversion is completed.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered October 5, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3870, provided for cancellation of the certificate of water right recorded at page 2579, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in that transfer proceeding or in this proceeding; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
