

On February 3, 1976, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John R. Palmer for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on October 1, 1979.

The certificate of water right heretofore recorded at page 31683, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was canceled by the order

of the Water Resources Director entered on September 15, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3417.






