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
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

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3957

On May 11, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by the United States of America, acting through the Regional Director of the Bureau of Reclamation, for approval of changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made of water from Sain Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 726, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Rodell Matteson, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second from Sain Creek for irrigation of 19.0 acres in SW4 NE4 and 8.0 acres in SE4 NW4 of Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 4, 1909.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 250 feet South and 250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW4 SW4 of Section 18, being within the NW4 SW4 of Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, is seeking approval of changes from the said point of diversion and use theretofore made, without loss of priority, to the existing use of the water for operation and maintenance of a public recreation area in NW4 SW4 and S½ SW4 of Section 7; and NW4 of Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M., by diversion from a point located 210 feet South and 415 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW4 SW4 of Section 14, being within the NW4 SW4 of Section 14, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Washington County News-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Washington County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 24 and 31; and June 7, 1978.

Mr. Clayton Gardner, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall be limited to the irrigation season of each year.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made of water are completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 726, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
