ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3997

On July 25, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Arie Jongeneel for approval of a change in point of appropriation from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 42032, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Samson Anfilofieff, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second from a certain ground water aquifer for irrigation of a certain 25.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 23.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7; and 1.4 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 8, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 11, 1968.

Water for the said right is appropriated from a well located 1350 feet South and 490 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of appropriation therefrom, without loss of priority, to a well located 2300 feet South and 1310 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Mr. William S. Bartholomew, Hydrogeologist, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

Mr. Clifton R. King, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of appropriation under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of appropriation is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 42032, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.33 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of
appropriation; SENE Sec 7 T6S R1E W.M., 1350' S & 490' W from NE cor Sec 7
 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W. M.,
1350 feet South and 490 feet West from NE Corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
 A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
