

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Lower Section of North Side Applegate River Ditch, from a point located 1550 feet South and 2200 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 21, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 21, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W.M.
