

of Kellogg Route, Box 81, Oakland , State of Oregon, 97462 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 35.7 acres

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 25778 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 5, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE SW4), Section 2, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 620 feet North and 1420 feet East; 40 feet North and 2250 feet East; both from the SW Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the Umpqua River is 525.0 c.f.s. or more at tidewater,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4002

On August 1, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Ted Osborn for approval of a change in point of diversion from Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 44046, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Milo Bullock, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from Umpqua River for irrigation of 0.1 acre in Lot 1 (NE% NW%) and 0.6 acre in Lot 1 (NW% NE%) of Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 5, 1958.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located 40 feet North and 2250 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 2, being within the SE4 SW4 of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1000 feet South and 2920 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion under the subject right described herein and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered September 5, 1978, approving transfer application No. 4015, provided for cancellation of the certificate of water right recorded at page 44046, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in that transfer proceeding or in this proceeding; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
