Harrell, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.011 cubic foot per second from North Umpqua River for irrigation of 0.9 acre in NW4 NE4, as projected within McKinney D.L.C. No. 45, Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 13, 1963.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located 2550 feet South and 2620 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 14, being within the SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 14, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 840 feet South and 2050 feet East from the Southeast Corner of Section 14, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 11, 18 and 25, 1978.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.
