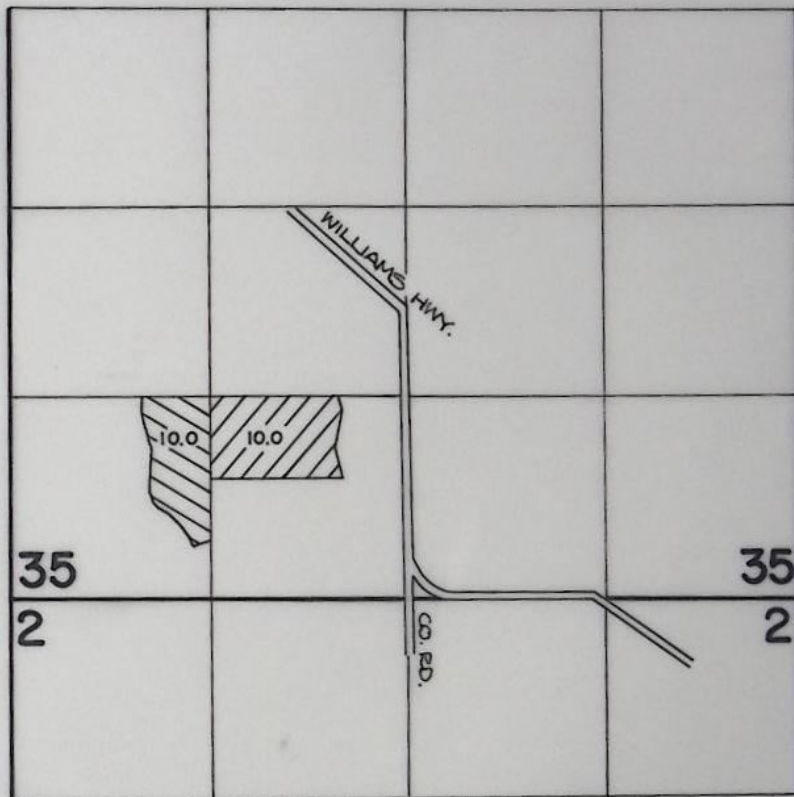

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4017

On August 7, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Lyle Woodcock for approval of a change in place of use of water from Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16313, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Minerva Topping, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second from Williams Creek for irrigation of a certain 10.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1858.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Watts-Topping Ditch, from a point located 460 feet North and 90 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 12, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof, a certain 10.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 16313, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under this provisions, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
