ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4026

On August 18, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by James S. and Theresa J. Littler for approval of a change in point of diversion from North Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 45495, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of G. H. Harrell, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.017 cubic foot per second from North Umpqua River for irrigation of 1.4 acres in NW¹₄ NE¹₄ of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 13, 1963.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said water right is located 2550 feet South and 2620 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 14, being within the SW_4^1 SE_4^1 of Section 14, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 740 feet South and 2050 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.


