

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ROBERT A. AND PATRICIA J. MATOVICH
BOX 197, S. MYRTLE ROLLE

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Fork Umpqua River for the purpose of Irrigation of 2.6 acres under Permit No. 4380 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Jamuary 9, 1920;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.033

O.25 cubic foot per second; if available of the panting point of diversion, SE NE Section 30 7295 Lyw wm, 1800 feet South and 250 left wort from the NE Coener The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per

acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Ten (10) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW1NE1) (Lot 1). Six (6) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE1NE1), and Four (4) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE1NE1) of Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-nine South of Hange Four West of the Willamette Meridian, in Douglas County, Oregon, seing a total of 20 acres.

2.2 acres NE NE 0.2 acre Lot I (NW NE) 0.2 acre SE NE Section 30 T.295, R.4W, WM.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the WRD entered Nov. 15, 1978 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page (A)(B)(D) &(E), Volume , SRWRC supersedes and together with adors of the wall entered Nov. 15, 1978 supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 5594, Volume 6, SRWRC.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3979

On June 20, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert A. and Patricia J. Matovich for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Myrtle Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 5594, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of A. L. Dyer, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second from South Myrtle Creek with a priority date of January 9, 1920, for irrigation of a certain 20.0 acres in NE4 of Section 30, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, W.M., tabulating the 20.0 acres as 10.0 acres in Lot 1 (NW4 NE4), 6.0 acres in NE4 NE4 and 4.0 acres in SE4 NE4. The actual location is determined to be 13.0 acres in Lot 1 (NW4 NE4), 4.0 acres in NE4 NE4 and 3.0 acres in SE4 NE4 of said Section 30.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 1800 feet South and 250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 30, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of a certain 0.2 acre in Lot 1 (NW4 NE4), 2.2 acres in NE4 NE4, and 0.2 acre in SE4 NE4 of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion of water for the irrigation of their lands, without loss of priority, to a point located 1350 feet South and 1230 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 30, being within the SW4 NE4 of Section 30, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that

the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diersion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.033 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion of water is completed.

The order entered November 15, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3977 provided for cancellation of the certificate recorded at page 5594, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended
under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be
issued to the applicants herein.
