

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4074

On October 13, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Steve Palfy for approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 302, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, describes a right tabulated in the name of Alex Thompson, which includes the use of water from Squaw Creek for irrigation of 22.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895.

As modified in accord with the provisions of orders of the State Engineer entered February 23, 1934, approving transfer application No. D-5 and entered October 19, 1936, approving transfer application No. S-12, a part of the right previously described by said certificate recorded at page 302 tabulated in the name of W. F. Fryrear, now exists for the use of water from Squaw Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 30.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 33, with a date of priority of November 11, 1895.

As modified in accord with the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3888, a right now exists for the use of water from Squaw. Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 4.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 33, with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and 4.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 33, with a date of priority of 1895.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 20.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 3 and 40.0 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use at a meeting held in August, 1978.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Squaw Creek Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.

ORDER

On August 27, 1979, Steve Palfy and on October 16, 1979 Bonnie L. Palfy, submitted affidavits that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911 and September 19, 1914 in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated in the name of R.R. Johnson at Page 127, Volume 1, and in the name of W. Edmunds at Page 475, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director. The water right being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 302d, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, as being for the use of not to exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of November 1904, for the irrigation of 15.5 acres in NW4 NW4 Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W.M.; and being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 850b, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates also in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company as being for the use of not to exceed 0.49 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of 1904, for the irrigation of 13.0 acres in SW4 SE4 Section 29, 3.0 acres in NE4 NE4 Section 32, 8.5 acres in NW4 NW4 Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W.M., which right was modified under the provision of the order of the State Engineer dated September 11, 1930 approving transfer application S-3 which changed the place of use from the above described lands to the NE4 NE4 Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificates recorded at Pages 302d and 850b, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates as modified by the provisions of an order of the State Engineer entered September 11, 1930, approving transfer application No. S-3, is canceled.

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



True value pending completion of a water transfer survey when on-going transfers #T-4074 & T-5711 have been completed by the State Water Resources Dept. allowing for future water transfers between the principals.


TL 14-11-33-2400 (Lot 9, Block 2) will have a tentative 9.8 acres of water per the Preliminary Draft of the Final Proof Survey. Any water transfer from this property will be at Johnson's option once the land sales contracts are complete. This exceeds the 5 acres intended to be applied by some 4.8 acres. Palfy agreed to transfer some 13.0 acres of water to Johnson in all. Thus, there remains a balance of 3.2 acres of water due Johnson.

Palfy intended for 30.0 acres of water to be transferred to Maxwell on TL 15-11-1101. However, the State has only allowed an allotment of 21.0 acres, ashortage of some 9.0 acres.

There are 17.8 acres shown on TL's 2500, 2600 & 2700 (Lots 4, 3 & 1 of Block 4). 0.4 acre has been inadvertently transferred to TL 2700 because of the showing of beneficial use. The only way this water can be retrieved is administratively by the state or a transfer from the landowner. Palfy intends to retain 10.0 acres of water on TL's 2500 & 2600 with a surplus of 7.4 acres available for transfer to Maxwell.

It is intended to retain 15.0 acres of water on TL15-11-4-600 with a surplus available for transfer of 4.4 acres of which 3.2 acres would go to Johnson and 1.2 acres would be available for transfer to Maxwell.

Further negotiations with Maxwell may result in reduced transfers if he feels that he has a sufficient supply. I have had no discussions with Maxwell inasmuch as this matter should be between Palfy and Maxwell.







Your two water right transfer applications for approval of changes in place of use of water from Squaw Creek, together with supporting maps and fees in the amount of \$68, were received October 13, 1978. Our receipts No. 6703 and 6704 are enclosed.

The application proposing a change for the 1904 priority has been assigned number 4073; for the 1895 priority, number 4074.

You have noted in item No. 10 of transfer application No. 4073, that a portion of the water right has undergone a period of five or more consecutive years of nonuse. If so, that portion of the water right would no longer be valid and it will be necessary to delete that portion of the water right from your application.

According to our records, the water right involved in transfer application No. 4073 was transferred in by an order of the State Engineer approving transfer No. S-3 and has, in part, a priority of 1904 and, in part, a priority of November, 1904. Also, according to our records, part of the water right involved in transfer application No. 4074 was involved in two earlier transfer proceedings, being the orders approving transfer applications No. D-5 and S-12. Also, all the water rights on transfer application No. 4074 would have the priority date of November 11, 1895. I have placed this information on the applications in pencil. If you agree, it should be entered in ink, or typed.

It will be necessary for you to further show on the map supporting application No. 4073, the lands to be covered by each priority date by shading in a different manner.

The map supporting application No. 4074 must be corrected to show the specific 30 acres in the SE_4^1 SW_4 of Section 33 to be divested of the water right.

The applications must be supported by statements from the holders of the mortgages advising that they are in agreement with the proposed changes in place of use. It will also be necessary to submit copies of the deeds showing current ownership of the lands from which the water rights are being transferred.




