

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

- On January 13, 2023, CITY OF FLORENCE, ATTN: MIKE MILLER, filed an application to add an additional point of appropriation under Permit G-16885. The Department assigned the application number T-14146.
- On January 19, 2012, the Department approved Permit Amendment T-11282, recorded as Special Order Volume 85, Page 957, approving an additional point of appropriation, identified as Well 13. The final order and superseding permit G-16885 contained a scrivener's error in the description of the QQ location, which appears in bold below:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 3. On September 29, 2020, the Department approved a Water Management and Conservation Plan (WMCP), recorded at Special Order Volume 117, Pages 607-608. The approved plan contains the following Development Limitation: The limitation of the diversion of water under Permit G-16885 established in the Final Order approving the City's previous WMCP issued on April 9, 2010, is now modified. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the City of Florence is now authorized to divert only up to 2.4 CFS (out of the total permitted 3.0 CFS) of water under Permit G-16885.
- 4. On August 11, 2023, pursuant to ORS 537.260 and OAR 690-320-0040(5), the Department approved the partial perfection of 2.4 CFS under Permit G-16885, recorded at Special Order Volume 128, Pages 831-832. Confirming Certificate 97298 was issued as a result of the approval of the partial perfection of Permit G-16885.
- Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on January 24, 2023, and in the Siuslaw News newspaper on September 25 and October 2, 2024, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5).
- On October 16, 2024, the Department contacted the agent for the applicant via phone regarding a deficiency in the application map, specifically Well 13 is described and mapped in the SW NE of T18S, R12W, Section 23.
- Permit Amendment Application T-14146 proposes an additional point of appropriation with the following approximate distances from the existing points of appropriation to:

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

- 8. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 10. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-14146 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-14146 is approved.
- Approval of this permit amendment application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new point of appropriation.
- Permit G-18896, in the name of CITY OF FLORENCE, is issued to replace Permit G-16885, and incorporates the amendment approved by this order and the Water Management and Conservation Plan. Permit G-16885, in the name of CITY OF FLORENCE, is no longer of any force or effect.
- 4. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (Well 14), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13).
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13).
- 7. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18896 remain the same.

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (Well 14), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13).

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13).

Permit Amendment T-11282 Conditions:

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 13), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12).

Prior to the water use from the proposed point of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or other measuring device in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided, however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12).

WMCP Conditions:

Duration of Plan Approval:

The City of Florence Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until September 10, 2030, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

Development Limitation:

The limitation of the diversion of water under Permit G-16885 established in the Final Order approving the City's previous WMCP issued on April 9, 2010, is now modified. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the City of Florence is now authorized to divert only up to 2.4cfs (out of the total permitted 3.0 cfs) of water under Permit G-16885.

Plan Update Schedule:

The City of Florence shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective November 1, 2002) within 10 years and no later than March 10, 2030.

Progress Report Schedule:

The City of Florence shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by September 10, 2025.

Other Requirements for Plan Submittal:

The deadline established herein for the submittal of an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan (consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 086) shall not relieve the City of Florence from any existing or future requirement(s) for submittal of a Water Management and Conservation Plan at an earlier date as established through other final orders of the Department.

Original Permit Conditions:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Within THREE years of permit issuance, the permittee shall submit a Water Management and Conservation Plan consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 86. The Director may approve an extension of this timeline to complete the required Water Management and Conservation Plan.

The City of Florence shall submit an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan no later than April 9, 2020, and shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by April 9, 2015.

Mitigation Condition #1: During the period October 16 through October 31 of each year after this permit is first exercised, the City will deliver to the wetlands adjacent to Munsel Creek the equivalent of 26% of the average pumping rate under this permit for the previous June, July, August, and September.

Mitigation Condition #2: Any time this permit is being exercised, all clarified backwash water from the City's water treatment plant will be diverted to wetlands adjacent to Munsel Creek.

Nothing in this permit shall be construed to allow any person to trespass on the lands of another person.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2025. If the water is not completely applied before this date, and the permittee wishes to continue development under the permit, the permittee must submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.



The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 13), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12).

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation (Wells 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12).

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Within THREE years of permit issuance, the permittee shall submit a Water Management and Conservation Plan consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 86. The Director may approve an extension of this timeline to complete the required Water Management and Conservation Plan.

The City of Florence shall submit an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan no later than April 9, 2020, and shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by April 9, 2015.

Mitigation Condition #1: During the period October 16 through October 31 of each year after this permit is first exercised, the City will deliver to the wetlands adjacent to Munsel Creek the equivalent of 26% of the average pumping rate under this permit for the previous June, July, August, and September.

Mitigation Condition #2: Any time this permit is being exercised, all clarified backwash water from the City's water treatment plant will be diverted to wetlands adjacent to Munsel Creek.

Nothing in this permit shall be construed to allow any person to trespass on the lands of another person.

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STANDARD CONDITIONS

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2025. If the water is not completely applied before this date, and the permittee wishes to continue development under the permit, the permittee must submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE).



Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-14146)

- Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any
 applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In
 making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
- Restrictions. Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
- Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$1,632.10. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$1,632.10 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
- b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.
- Confidentiality. Applicant agrees that any information provided to or acquired by OWRD under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law and shall be considered public records.
- 6. Indemnity. Applicant shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify the State of Oregon, OWRD, and their officers, employees, and agents from and against all claims, suits, actions, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses of any nature resulting from or arising out of, or relating to the activities of Applicant or its representatives, officers, employees, contractors, or agents under this Agreement or with respect to the expedited service. The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

- 7. Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- 8. Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate.
