 Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 8. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- The proposed changes would prevent the lands from which the water right is removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred right, as required by ORS 540.523(7).
- 10. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

- The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 79798.
- The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

9. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 79798 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 79798.


