#### Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

- Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.





Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not *temporarily* use water at the new place of use until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands <u>from</u> which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land <u>to</u> which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.







I have a few concerns that I would like to address before submitting my WM review for T-14271.

Looking at the transfer map, it appears the applicant is either planning to run a pipeline directly down Jumpoff Joe Creek, or they are implying that Jumpoff Joe Creek will be used as their conveyance system, which isn't an option. To take water out of Jumpoff Joe Creek where the dashed line exists the channel would require a downstream POD transfer or APOD, which doesn't appear to be a component of the application. I think it's important that the applicant provide clarification on this matter.



Scott – would you be able to provide me with a copy of the evidence of use imagery submitted with the application? The copy in WRIS looks like a bad scan. I have concerns over beneficial use on the 0.41 acres in the NWNE.




