- Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 29, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On November 10, 2021, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13523 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of December 13, 2021, for the applicants to respond. The Department did not receive a response.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On December 28, 2021, the Department contacted the applicants' agent by written correspondence, as the December 13, 2021 deadline was not met for receiving a response. The Department set forth a deadline of January 14, 2022, for the applicants to respond.

No protests were filed in response to the notice.
