Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On July 29, 2021, KNEE DEEP CATTLE CO. and MIKE STEVENSON filed an application to change the place of use under Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91761. The Department assigned the application number T-13782.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 17, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. Transfer Application T- 13782 proposes to transfer water rights within the boundaries of Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project (District) involving the certificates held by the District. On July 26, 2021, the District certified that they consented to the applicant's proposed water right transfer application and maps.
4. After proof of completion, any water right certificate issued to confirm or to describe confirmed changes to Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91761 under Transfer T-13782 are to remain in the name of the Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. On August 8, 2024, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13782. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of September 7, 2024, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
6. On November 6, 2024, the Department determined that the portion of the rate to be transferred under Certificate 80835 was less than originally proposed. Therefore, the Department determined that a revised draft Preliminary Determination should be issued.
7. On December 26, 2024, the Department sent a revised draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13782. The revised draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 25, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.
8. On April 14, 2025, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13782 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on April 15, 2025, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
9. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 80835 in the name of MUDDY CREEKS IRRIGATION DISTRICT (perfected under Permit S-50921)

Use: IRRIGATION OF 82.9 ACRES

Priority Dates and Rates: AUGUST 13, 1986 for 0.038 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, AND OCTOBER 2, 1986 FOR 0.998 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2) and 690-380-2200]

13. Water has been used the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13782 according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
14. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13782.
15. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
16. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the rights.
17. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
18. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13782 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13782 is approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91716 and any related decree.
3. Water right Certificates 91716, 86338, and 80835 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing that portion of the rights not affected by this transfer.
4. After proof of completion, any water right certificate issued to confirm or to describe confirmed changes to Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91761 under Transfer T-13782 are to remain in the name of the Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project.
5. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
7. After satisfactory proof of completion has been determined by the Department, superseding water right certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued in the name of Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project.

confirms the right to use the waters of the MCKENZIE RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER for of IRRIGATION OF 2004.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50921. The dates of priority are AUGUST 13, 1986, FOR 0.923 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AND OCTOBER 2, 1986, FOR 24.131 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 25.09 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This certificate does not include rights inchoate under Transfer Application T-6999. The inchoate rights allow for the irrigation of 6.7 acres. The dates of priority are AUGUST 13, 1986, for 0.003 CFS AND OCTOBER 2, 1986, for 0.081 CFS







Findings of Fact

1. On July 29, 2021, KNEE DEEP CATTLE CO. and MIKE STEVENSON filed an application to change the place of use under Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91761. The Department assigned the application number T-13782.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 17, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. Transfer Application T- 13782 proposes to transfer water rights within the boundaries of Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project (District) involving the certificates held by the District. On July 26, 2021, the District certified that they consented to the applicant's proposed water right transfer application and maps.
4. After proof of completion, any water right certificate issued to confirm or to describe confirmed changes to Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91761 under Transfer T-13782 are to remain in the name of the Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, of this preliminary determination.

5. On August 8, 2024, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13782. 14. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13782.
15. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
16. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the rights.
17. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
18. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action


The change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13782 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13782 is approved, the final order will include the following:

1. *The change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13782 is approved.*

2. *The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 80835, 86338, and 91716 and any related decree.*
3. *Water right Certificates 91716, 86338, and 80835 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing that portion of the rights not affected by this transfer.*
4. *The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.*
5. *Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.*
6. *After satisfactory proof of completion has been determined by the Department, superseding water right certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued in the name of Muddy Creeks Irrigation Project.*

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.



Water for the rights described in this transfer application is pumped from the Muddy Creek Irrigation canal, diverted from the McKenzie River at NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T 17S, R 3W, W.M. being 4440 feet south and 5250 feet east from the southeast corner of DCL 79. It is then further diverted from the Muddy Creek canal at a pump house on Roberts Rd. in Coburg, OR on the west side of I-5. This water is conveyed through pipe laid under the freeway prior to its construction, due to an easement from June 11, 1943 (instrument #121919, document #42662). The water enters Mike Stevenson's ditch on the east side of the freeway, south of Van Dyrn Rd and through property owned by Mike Stevenson, flows underneath Van Dyrn Rd and onto property also owned by Mike Stevenson. Water was previously pumped into a series of antiquated wheel line irrigation systems North and south

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Part 5

of Van Duzen Rd. This system worked to utilize water rights in their current location, but lacked the water, energy, and labor saving technology of modern irrigation systems. The proposed transfer would allow Mike Stevenson to apply water with a highly efficient, sophisticated center pivot system at the North end of his property. In the proposed location, water will be pumped from the ditch by a 60 HP Gould Inc. Century pump with a capacity to run at 3540 RPM. The water will be directed to the center pivot and delivered to the ground by low-pressure sprinklers. It is the wish of the applicant that this change serves to make better use of our limited water resources by utilizing the more sustainable irrigation systems that have recently been developed.
