Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

SKYE AND PENNY KREBS 73654 HWY 74 IONE, OR 97843

Findings of Fact

- On June 2, 2023, Skye and Penny Krebs filed an application for an additional point of diversion under Certificate 88208, to move the points of diversion under Certificates 67246 and 91444 and to change the places of use under Certificates 67246, 88208, 91444, and 95946. The Department assigned the application number T-14259.
- Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 13, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On May 2, 2024, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14259 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of June 1, 2024, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On May 15, 2024, the Department received a letter from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), indicating the applicant has a fish screen installed at the new points of diversion.
- 5. On May 16, 2024, the applicant's agent requested a new completion date of October 1, 2027, due to the complexities of the project. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-5140(3), the Department has modified the completion date of Transfer Application T-14259 to October 1, 2027.
- 6. On October 18, 2024, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14259 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on October 22, 2024, and in the East Oregonian newspaper on November 6 and 13, 2024, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notices.
- 7. On December 19, 2024, the Department determined there to be a scrivener's error in Condition #4 of the Preliminary Determination. Certificate 88208 will be cancelled, and no remaining right will be issued, as the entire right is affected by transfer T-14259. This condition was added as Condition #5 in this Order.
- 8. On December 30, 2024, ODFW provided the Department with a revised review for the fish screen condition, specifically to maintain the currently installed fish screen at the new points of diversion.

22. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that a fish screen is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and that the diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2) and 690-380-2110(2), and 690-380-22001

- 23. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 24. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14259.
- 25. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 26. The proposed points of diversion divert water from the same source of surface water as the authorized points of diversion, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).
- 27. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the rights.

- 28. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 29. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The additional point of diversion, change in points of diversion and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14259 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional point of diversion, changes in points of diversion and changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14259 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the places of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 67246, 88208, 91444, and 95946 and any related decree.
- Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new points of diversion or the new places of use.
- Water right Certificates 67246, 91444, and 95946 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of Certificates 67246, 914444, and 95946 not affected by this transfer.
- Water right Certificate 88208 is cancelled.
- Under Certificate 67246, the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD

 shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD).
- Under Certificate 88208, the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD

 together with the quantity diverted at the original points of diversion (POD), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD).
- Under Certificate 91444, the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD

 shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD).
- Water shall be acquired from the same source of surface water as the original points of diversion.
- The former places of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.

11. Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 12. The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion. If Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.
- 13. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2027. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 14. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 11. The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion. If Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

- 12. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2027**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 13. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

Protests

The person's name, address, and telephone number;

- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting
 the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably
 ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the
 Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the
 issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested
 cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all
 parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.

Notice Regarding Servicemembers: Active-duty servicemembers have a right to stay proceedings under the federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act. 50 U.S.C. App. §§501-597b. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) is submitting this letter regarding fish screening and passage for the transfer T-14259 in the name of Penny and Skye Krebs. ODFW submitted a review on 6/21/2023, indicating that the point of diversion must be screened, and the transfer may trigger fish passage requirements. On 5/7/2024 OWRD reached out about an ODFW screen certification letter for the two existing PODs, dated June 10, 2021. On 5/8/2024 Water Program staff coordinated with Fish Screening Program staff and determined that the approved fish screens can accommodate the increased rate of diversion from T-14259.

ODFW has also determined that the proposed point of diversion related to T-14259 is existing and does not trigger fish passage requirements. However, the permittee shall maintain adequate passage of native migratory fish at all times (ORS 509.610) at the point of diversion and shall not construct, operate, or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage across any waters of the state that are inhabited, or were historically inhabited, by native migratory fish (ORS 509.585).

Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-14259)

- 1. Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
- Restrictions. Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
- 3. Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$1,716.82. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$1,716.82 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
- b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.
- 5. Confidentiality. Applicant agrees that any information provided to or acquired by OWRD under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law and shall be considered public records.
- 6. Indemnity. Applicant shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify the State of Oregon, OWRD, and their officers, employees, and agents from and against all claims, suits, actions, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses of any nature resulting from or arising out of, or relating to the activities of Applicant or its representatives, officers, employees, contractors, or agents under this Agreement or with respect to the expedited service. The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.



- Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The
 Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon
 receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- 8. Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
 - 10. Completion Date. OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.
 - Captions. The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define, limit, or describe the scope, or intent, of any provision of this Agreement.
 - 12. Amendment and Merger. The terms of this Agreement shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented, or amended in any manner whatsoever, except by written instrument signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. Irrigation water is pumped from Willow Creek with a 7.5 horsepower electrical pump. The water is used to irrigate two fields. The southerly field is the smaller of the two in is somewhat irregular in shape. The northerly field is the larger of the two and is generally rectangular in shape.

The pump discharges into a buried 4" PVC pipeline that extends 160 feet +/- in a northwesterly direction across the northerly end of the smaller field to the northwesterly edge of the field. The northwesterly edge of the farm field is the southeasterly edge of the yard around the farmhouse. At this point there is a 90 degree bend to the southwest and the pipeline continues for 70 feet +/- and then bends the northwest and continues another 70 feet +/-. There are riser valves along the above described pipeline. A combination of a 480 foot +/- wheel line and portable hand lines are used to irrigate the southerly field.

There is a tee pipe fitting in the buried pump discharge line. It is located 60 feet +/- from the pump. The branch of the tee is oriented to extend in a northeasterly direction. A 170 foot +/- 4" buried PVC pipeline connects to the tee. The end of the 170 foot +/- pipe line connects to a 600" +/- pipeline that extends in a northwesterly direction along the southerly end of the larger field. This pipeline serves as the main line for the larger field. There are riser valves along this mainline. The majority of this field is irrigated with a ¼ mile wheel line. The southeasterly corner of this field is irrigated with portable hand lines.

The ditch flows north 330 feet \pm and then bends to the northwest and more or less parallels Highway 74 for 1970 feet \pm . From this point it bends around some farmstead buildings for 810 feet \pm where it continues paralleling Highway 74 for an additional 730 feet \pm . Water is diverted out of the ditch and flooded across the fields to irrigate the ground. In instances where the water will not gravity flow from the ditch the water user uses a PTO driven pump to pump the water from the ditch onto the farmland. The pump is a Dyna Flo Pump driven by a tractor PTO. It has a capacity of 3000 gpm (6.68 cfs).



I am assisting Skye and Penny Krebs with their water right transfer application that includes a portion of Certificate 91444. This letter is in response to your May 2, 2023 letter to them.

With this letter an updated transfer application is being submitted. The application documents are the original documents with updated evidence of use images for Certificate 91444. In this submittal there are three colored images in support of Evidence of use for Certificate 91444. Two of the images are the same images that were included with the original transfer application. The labels on the images have been updated to include a designation of Photo 1 or Photo 2. The third image is a colored google image that covers the area of Certificate 91444, the SWNW and the SENW of Section 26, T3N R22E W.M. On this image there are tacks identifying the locations where Photo 1 and Photo 2 were taken. In the background of Photo 1 and Photo 2 you can see a bridge structure. This is the Rhea Lane bridge that crosses Willow Creek. Although the bridge is not labelled on the google image, Rhea Lane is. Using the bridge as a reference you can determine where Photos 1 and 2 were taken and the direction of the photos. Hopefully this addresses the issues you identified in your letter.

The owner's son, Kip Krebs, has numerous pictures showing water being diverted from Willow Creek for irrigation of the land authorized under Certificate 91444. The water is routed down historical channels and allowed to flood irrigate the ground. Sheep are then grazed on the ground.

Kip Krebs has informed me he has coordinated his efforts of diverting water for flood irrigation with the watermaster, Ken Thiemann. 
