

Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of appropriation authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On July 31, 2023, Ronald Major Defoe filed an application to temporarily change the place of use and change the points of appropriation to serve the proposed place of use under Certificate 38463 for a period of 5 years. The Department assigned the application number T-14289.

2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 8, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000.

3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate:	38463 in the name of GORDON ELLIOTT (perfected under Permit G-3413)
Use:	IRRIGATION of 53.0 ACRES
Priority Date:	APRIL 5, 1967
Rate:	0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM WELL NO. 1 AND 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM WELL NO. 2

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
8. The proposed changes would prevent the lands from which the water right is removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred right, as required by ORS 540.523(7).
9. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law


The temporary changes in place of use and points of appropriation to serve the temporary place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14289 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The temporary changes in place of use and change in points of appropriation to serve the temporary place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14289 are approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2028 irrigation season. The authorization to use the temporary points of appropriation shall be terminated concurrently.

4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary points of appropriation (Wells G, H, and O) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Wells 1 and 2).
6. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificate 38463 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
7. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 38463.
8. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of appropriation with the exception that water rights issued to the Bureau of Reclamation or an irrigation district (or similar entity) are not subject to this condition.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
10. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 38463 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 38463.

The information provided in the application is insufficient to evaluate whether the proposed transfer may be approved because:

- ☐ The water well reports provided with the application do not correspond to the water rights affected by the transfer.
- ☐ The application does not include water well reports or a description of the well construction details sufficient to establish the ground water body developed or proposed to be developed.

1. Basic description of the changes proposed in this transfer: The applicant proposes to temporarily change 53 acres of POU and three POAs; the from-POAs are "Well 1" (LANE 11705) and "Well 2" (LANE 11707); the to-POAs are "Well G" (LANE 71633), "Well H" (PROP 370), and "Well O" (LANE 73396). The from-POAs are authorized under Certificate 38463 to irrigate 134.3 ac, with Well 1 (LANE 11705) limited to 0.74 cfs and Well 2 (LANE 11707) limited to 0.94 cfs for 1.68 cfs total. The applicant is limited to the apportioned rate based on the original certificate and the transferred acres per POA in Table 2 of application: Well G (LANE 71633) used for 3.8 ac for a maximum rate of 0.047 cfs (21 gpm) and a maximum annual duty of 9.5 AF; Well H (PROP 370) used for 41.9 ac for a maximum rate of 0.52 cfs (233 gpm) and a maximum annual duty of 104.75 AF; Well O (LANE 73396) used on 7.3 ac for a maximum rate of 0.091 cfs (41 gpm) and a maximum annual duty of 18.25 AF.

Well G (LANE 71633) is also a POA on application G-19362 for nursery use on 30 acres at 0.75 cfs (337 gpm) and a maximum annual volume of 150 AF. Well O (LANE 73396) is also a POA on application G-19313 for nursery use on 7.3 ac at 0.18 cfs (81 gpm) and a maximum annual volume of 36.5 AF. These applications were submitted prior to T-14289, and the total combined rates per POA will be evaluated for T-14289 and are presented in the table below.

The existing to-POAs (LANE 71633 and LANE 73396) develop the same aquifer. The proposed to-POA (PROP 370) is anticipated to develop the same aquifer, based on the construction information provided by the applicant.

The closest groundwater users to the to-Wells are: the domestic well serving tax lot 1201 at 30386 Beacon Dr at an elevation of 375 ft amsl located 1,577 ft east of Well G (LANE 71633); domestic well serving tax lot 1200 at 90980 River Rd at an elevation of 371 ft amsl located 258 ft northwest of Well H (PROP 370); LANE 76550 at an elevation of 370 located 221 ft southeast of Well O (LANE 73396). Provide context for minimal/significant impact: Although Well H (PROP 370) is closer to Spring Creek than either of the from-POAs, the other two to-POAs are further from Spring Creek. In addition, the shortest POA-SW distance is Well 2 (LANE 11707) and Flat Creek. The summed POA-SW distance for the to-POAs exceeds the summed POA-SW distance for the from-POAs by 2,134 ft. Flat Creek and Spring Creek are in the same WAB, WILLAMETTE R>COLUMBIA R-AB PERIWINKLE CR AT GAGE 14174. The overall impact to surface water is anticipated to be similar, and potentially reduced. The change in degree of interference is anticipated to be minimal.

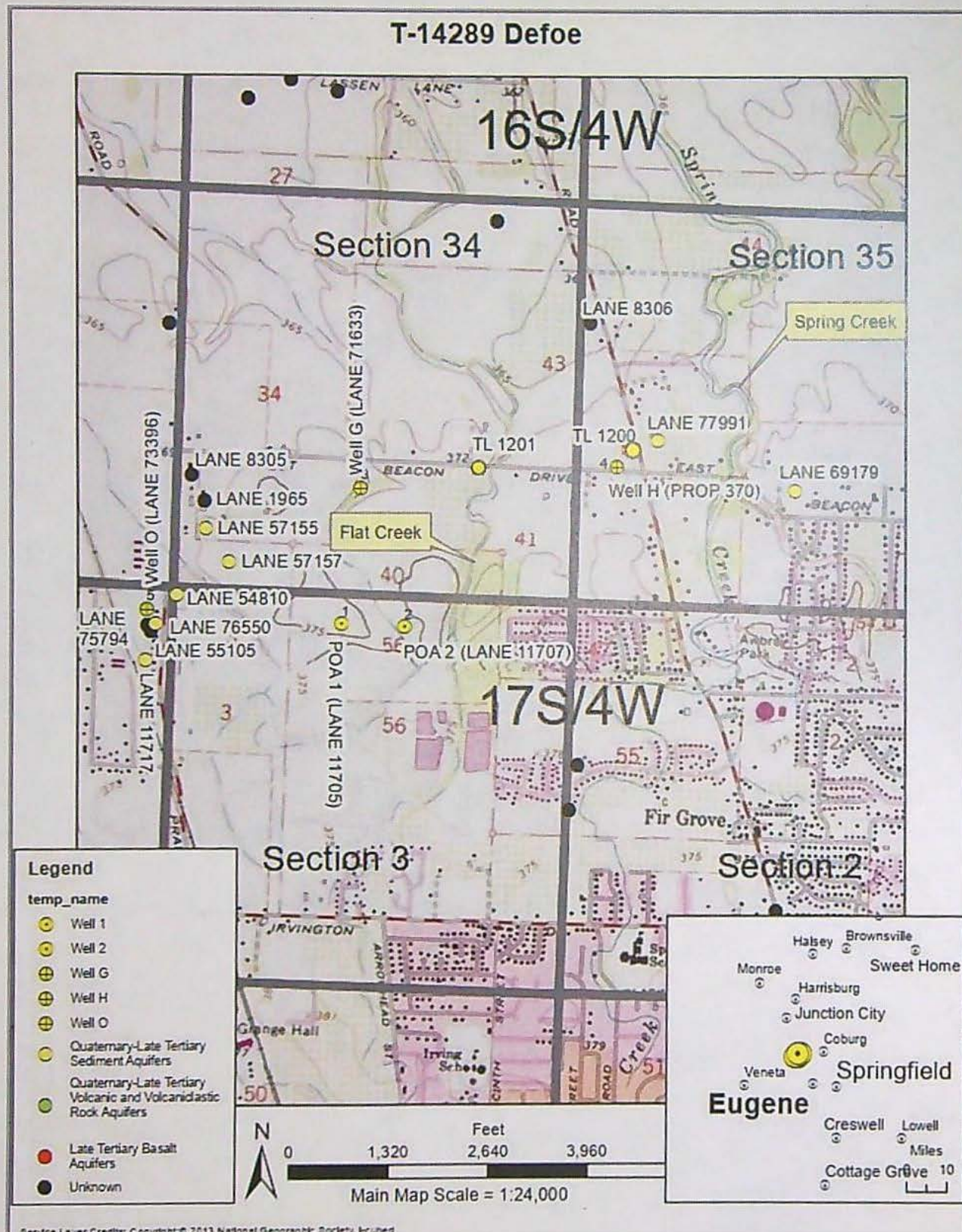

On July 31, 2023, the Department received your water right Temporary Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$1043.10. Receipt number 141278 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not **temporarily** use water at the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands from which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land to which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.
