- On January 4, 2024, SHORTLAND GOLF CLUB AKA SHORTY'S GOLF COURSE LLC, C/O MIKE FRITZ, filed an application for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation and to change the place of use under Certificate 50575. The Department assigned the application number T-14377.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 9, 2024, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On March 18, 2024, The Department determined that the proposed additional points of appropriation (APOAs) would not develop the same aquifer as the existing points of appropriation (POAs):
 - a) Currently authorized POAs develop the Columbia River Basalt Group (CRBG) aquifer system, which is first reported at 362 and 540 feet bls.

- b) The proposed APOA, Shop Well, would be completed to a depth of 650 feet, with casing to 350 feet bls and sealed to a depth of 75 feet bls. As proposed, the construction of the well could allow the alluvial and CRBG aquifers to comingle, partially developing water from the alluvial aquifer.
- c) The proposed APOA, Club House Well is completed to a total depth of 278 feet bls, developing the alluvial aquifer system above the CRBG aquifer system, therefore not developing the same aquifer (source of water).
- 4. On March 18, 2024, The Department also determined that the proposed APOA's would likely result in significant interference with the Willamette River:
 - a) Based on available information, the authorized POAs do not have an effective hydraulic connection with nearby surface water. However, the proposed APOA "Club House Well" appears to produce from the alluvial aquifer, which would increase interference with nearby surface water sources.
 - b) Based on the construction of the proposed APOAs and production from hydraulically connected aquifers, the interference with the nearby surface water source (Willamette River) is expected to be significant in comparison with the currently authorized current authorized POAs.
- On March 28, 2024, The Department notified the applicant's agent that permit G-18861 is layered with the authorized place of use. The place of use of Certificate 50575 that is being changed, is changing within the place of use of Permit G-18861.
- On March 29, 2024, the applicant provided additional information about the hydrogeological structures in the area for the Department to consider.
- 7. On April 8, 2024, the Department considered the agent's additional information and contacted the applicant's agent via email, reaffirming the initial determination that the proposed additional points of appropriation (APOAs) would not develop the same aquifer as the existing points of appropriation (POAs).
- On September 19, 2024, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary
 Determination proposing to deny Transfer Application T-14377 to the applicant. The draft
 Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of October 19, 2024, for the
 applicant to respond.
- 9. On October 17, 2024, the applicant's agent submitted an amended application and application map, changing the location and depth of the proposed well. The applicant also requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer and amended the application.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2), OAR 690-380-2110(2) and OAR 690-380-2200]

- 16. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 17. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14377.
- 18. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 19. The new proposed point of appropriation would develop groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized points of appropriation, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).



- 7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 8. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2026. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting
 the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably
 ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the
 Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the
 issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested
 cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all
 parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.

Therefore, this is effectively a transfer of the subject acreage from Well 2 ("From-POA") to Proposed Pond Well ("To-POA"). The applicant is also proposing to change the POU for the subject 11.8 acres, though that is not the subject of this review. Certificate 50575 authorizes irrigation of 51.5 acres total at a maximum rate of 0.32 cfs from any combination of Well 1 (CLAC 9317) and Well 2 (CLAC 9316). 

The To-POA is proposed to be completed to a total depth between 290 and 1000 ft bls, with casing and seal extending "0 to 5 feet into basalt." NOTE: Current well construction regulations for sealing into consolidated formations (OAR 690-210-0150) require casing and seal extend to at least five feet into solid, unfractured, consolidated rock overlying the water-bearing rock formation. The applicant's agent has provided analysis indicating that, at the location of the proposed To-POA, the solid, unfractured Columbia River Basalt likely exists at greater than ~370-380 ft bls (~-140 to -150 ft msl) based on the well reports for CLAC 9317 (authorized POA) and CLAC 9296 (neighboring well) (see attached Annotated Agent Cross Section). This largely agrees with the well report for CLAC 18564, which appears to be the closest well to the proposed To-POA and indicates weathered basalt from 357 to 363 ft bls (~-113 to -119 ft msl) and more competent basalt from 363-370 ft bls (~-119 to -126 ft msl). Based on the well report for CLAC 18564 and the land surface elevation at the proposed To-POA, the proposed To-POA would need to be cased and sealed to at least ~350 ft bls to meet well construction standards and only produce from the basalt aguifer. 



- Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any
 applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$2,687.94 \$3,586.46. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$2,687.94 \$3,586.46 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. - 7. Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
- 10. Completion Date. OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.
- Captions. The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define, limit, or describe the scope, or intent, of any provision of this Agreement.
- 12. Amendment and Merger. The terms of this Agreement shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented, or amended in any manner whatsoever, except by written instrument signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. There are no understandings, agreements or representations, oral or written, not specified herein regarding this Agreement.

- A. Grantor owns certain real property located in Clackamas County, Oregon which is more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Sandelie Property"). Grantee owns certain real property located in Clackamas County which is adjacent to the Sandelie Property, and which is more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto (the "Fritz Property").
- B. A well identified in the records of the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD") as CLAC 9317 (along with its associated pumping and electrical equipment) is located on the Sandelie Property (the "Well"). The Well supplies water for irrigation purposes to the Sandelie Property and the Fritz Property, pursuant to Water Right Certificate 50575 (the "Water Right") on file with OWRD and attached hereto as Exhibit C. The approximate location of the Well is shown as well # 1 on the final proof map included in Exhibit C.
- C. Grantor and Grantee desire to enter into this Well Easement and Water Use Agreement ("Agreement") to establish their respective rights and obligations pertaining to the access, use, operation, and maintenance of the Well and to establish other rights and obligations as provided herein.
- D. A separate well identified in the records of OWRD as CLAC 9316 and designated as well #2 in the Water Right is located at another location on the Sandelie Property. An exempt well identified in the records of OWRD as CLAC 8196 (deepened by log CLAC 52192/ID L03011) is located on the Fritz Property. CLAC 9316 and CLAC 8196 are not covered by this Agreement; Grantor has exclusive use of CLAC 9316 and Grantee has exclusive use of CLAC 8196.

Received by OWRD 0CT 1 0 2024 Salem. OR E. CLAC 9316 and CLAC 9317 are also the designated points of appropriation for Permit G-16291, held by Grantor. The water use authorized by Permit G-16291 is not covered by this Agreement.

In consideration of the following mutual covenants, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Grant of Easement. Grantor hereby grants and conveys to Grantee an easement to that portion of the Sandelie Property that is 50 feet in width from the Well to the Fritz Property (the "Easement"): (i) to use and convey water from the Well to the Fritz Property through an underground pipeline; (ii) to enter upon such portion of the Sandelie Property over the location of the pipeline to install, maintain, repair, and replace the pipeline, according to the terms of Section 4 below; and (iii) to enter upon such portion of the Sandelie Property over the location of the pipeline to operate, maintain, and repair the Well, according to the terms of Section 4 below.
- Location of Easement. The Easement will be located along the most direct, practicable route from the Well to the Fritz Property, beginning at the Well, 2050 feet south and 1560 feet west from the N 1/4 corner of Section 16, and running generally northeast to the southwest corner of the Fritz Property (the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, T3S, R1E), approximately as shown on Exhibit D.
- 3. Nature of Easement. Subject to possible termination under Section 15, the Easement and rights granted herein shall be perpetual and non-exclusive. The Easement and the obligations described herein shall run with the land and shall bind and inure to the benefit of Grantor, Grantee, and each of their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns. Grantor may also make any use of its property burdened by the Easement that is consistent with its current or future ownership of the Sandelie Property, as long as such use does not unreasonably interfere with Grantee's use of the Easement as provided in this Agreement.
- 4. Installation, Maintenance, and Repair; Cost Allocation; Utilities.
- 4.1 Pipeline Installation, Maintenance, and Repair. Within two years of the effective date of this Agreement, Grantee shall install a new, separate pipeline to convey water from the Well to the Fritz Property ("Fritz Pipeline"), located as described in Section 2 above. Grantee shall be solely responsible for the installation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of the Fritz Pipeline. All work performed on the Fritz Pipeline shall be completed in a workmanlike manner, free of claims and liens. Until the Fritz Pipeline is installed, Grantor and Grantee will share the existing pipeline running from the Well to the Fritz Property, including sharing equally (50-50) the costs of any maintenance or repairs of the existing pipeline. Upon completion of the installation, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Fritz Pipeline, Grantee shall restore the surface of the Sandelie Property to its previous condition.
- 4.2 Well Maintenance and Repair. Sandelie will maintain and repair the Well in a good and safe condition and replace mechanical components of the Well as needed ("Well Maintenance"). Fritz may, upon not less than 24 hours advance written notice, perform any necessary emergency maintenance or repairs to the Well in the event Sandelie is not available to perform such repairs. All work performed on the Well shall be completed in a workmanlike manner, free of claims and liens. Each party shall pay its share of the cost of Well Maintenance in proportion to that party's irrigated acreage served by the Well (Sandelie, 77%; Fritz, 23%); provided, however, that neither party shall commence any shared Well Maintenance exceeding \$2,500.00 in cost without first obtaining the verbal consent of the other party, which consent

shall not be unreasonably withheld. A party shall pay its share of Well Maintenance costs within 10 days of receipt of a written statement setting forth the amount thereof, accompanied by a copy of the third party bills or paid receipts showing the nature of the expenses in reasonable detail.

4.4 Utilities. Fritz shall pay 23% of all utility charges incurred and attributable to the operation of the Well for irrigation purposes. Fritz's share of the utility charges shall be payable annually and shall be paid by Fritz within 10 days of receipt of a written statement setting forth the amount thereof.

5. Use of Water/Measurement/Allocation of Shortage.

- 5.1 Use of Water. The Water Right authorizes irrigation of 51.5 acres in total—39.7 acres on the Sandelie Property and 11.8 acres on the Fritz Property, withdrawn at the rate of 0.32 cfs, up to a maximum volume of 2.5 acre feet of water per acre during the irrigation season of each year. Subject to Section 5.3 below, Grantor shall be entitled to withdraw water from the Well to irrigate 39.7 acres of land on the Sandelie Property and other property owned by Grantor, up to a maximum of 99.25 acre feet annually, and Grantee shall be entitled to withdraw water from the Well to irrigate 11.8 acres of land on the Fritz Property, up to a maximum of 29.5 acre feet annually. Grantee's use of the water from the Well shall be for irrigation purposes only and only in the locations authorized by the Water Right, unless a change in character of use or change in place of use is authorized by OWRD.
- 5.2 Measurement. At its own cost, Grantee shall install a totalizing flow meter on the Fritz Pipeline to measure its separate water use, and shall maintain the meter in good working order and keep a record of the amount of water used each month. Upon request, Grantee shall share its water use records with Grantor.
- 5.3 Allocation of Shortage. If insufficient water is available from the Well to supply Grantor and Grantee with their full rate and duty of water, the available water shall be shared by Grantor and Grantee in the following percentages:

Grantor 77% Grantee 23%

- 6 Curing Defaults. If either party hereto shall default with respect to any of its obligations set forth herein (including its maintenance obligations), the other party shall have the right to complete such work and seek reimbursement for the cost thereof plus interest thereon at the rate of 9% per annum, provided that the delinquent party shall have been given prior written notice and a reasonable opportunity not to exceed ten days to complete such repair work.
- 7. Indemnity. Each party shall at all times protect, indemnify, defend, and save and hold harmless the other party from all claims, demands, liens, charges, encumbrances, losses, costs (including attorney fees before trial, at trial, and on any appeal), and litigation arising directly or indirectly out of (i) any breach or default under this Agreement by the party; or (ii) liability for bodily injury or death or property damage resulting from any tort of the party.
- Noninterference. The parties to this Agreement shall not unreasonably interfere with
 the use of the Well by any person entitled to do so under the terms of this Agreement, provided
 such use is in the manner and for the purposes contemplated under this Agreement.

- 9. Cooperation. The parties to this Agreement shall cooperate with each other in good faith and shall execute such further documents and shall perform such further acts as may be reasonably necessary or appropriate to carry out and accomplish the intent of this Agreement.

Notice to any party to this Agreement shall be in writing and either personally delivered or sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the party to be notified at the addresses specified herein. Any such notice shall be deemed received on the date of personal delivery to the party (or such parties authorized representative) or three (3) business days after deposit in the U.S. Mail, as the case may be. Until any party notifies the other party as to a change of its address for notice purposes, notice to the parties shall be sent to the above addresses
- 11. Attorney Fees. In the event legal action is commenced in connection with this Agreement, the prevailing party in such action shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred in the trial court and in the appeal therefrom.
- 12. Severability. If any term, provision, or condition contained in this Agreement shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby, and each term, provision, and condition of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- Applicable Law. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.
- 14. Entire Agreement. This Agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties and any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this Agreement shall not be binding upon either party except to the extent incorporated into this Agreement. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts.
- 15. Termination by Grantee. Grantee may terminate this Agreement upon 90 days' written notice to Grantor, provided, however, that Grantee shall remain obligated to pay its share of any costs incurred prior to the date of notice pursuant to Section 4 above, and provided further that Grantee shall record a Termination of Easement ("Termination"), having first received Grantor's approval of the language of said Termination.

At this depth, proposed APOA Shop Well would likely partially develop the CRB aquifer system; however, proposed construction for APOA Shop Well may not be adequate to meet current well construction regulations for sealing into consolidated formations (OAR 690-210-0150) and as currently proposed, the well could commingle alluvial and CRB aquifers. Unless additional information is provided, the current construction for APOA Shop Well does not develop the same aquifer as the existing authorized POA.

The deepening log for Club House Well (CLAC 52192) indicates that the well was deepened from the likely original depth of 181 feet bls to a total depth of 278 feet bls and the lithology is reported between those depths as "broken gray green conglomerate" and "broken gray green brown red conglomerate". Based on the mapped depth to CRB and well log descriptions, this is likely alluvium overlying the CRBG. Based on the information available in the deepening log, CLAC 52192 does not appear to extend into the CRB and does not develop the CRB aquifer(s); therefore proposed APOA Club House Well does not produce from the same source as the currently authorized POAs. If the applicant provides additional information regarding the construction or lithology of the well, the well may be reconsidered.





Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-14377)

- Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any
 applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In
 making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
- Restrictions. Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
- Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$2,687.94. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$2,687.94 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
- b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.

The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

- 7. Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- 8. Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
- 10. Completion Date. OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.



ACCESS EASEMENT

THIS ACCESS EASEMENT (this "Easement Agreement"), dated and effective September 22, 2022 (the "Effective Date"), is by and between JANET M. KAISER ("Grantor") and MICHAEL W. FRITZ, Trustee of the Michael W. Fritz Trust UTA DTD April 2, 2015 ("Grantee").

RECITALS

- A. Pursuant to a Real Estate Sale Agreement dated August 12, 2022 (the "Sale Agreement"), Sandelie Golf Club, Inc. ("Sandelie") sold to Grantee approximately 30 acres of real property located in Clackamas County, Oregon and legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Golf Course Property").
- B. Pursuant to the Sale Agreement, Sandelie agreed to provide Grantee a temporary easement over Grantor's adjacent property described on Exhibit B attached hereto (the "Easement Property") to construct a new access driveway on the Golf Course Property. Grantor and Grantee desire to establish a right-of-way for construction of the access driveway upon the terms and conditions set forth below.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Grant of Easement. Grantor hereby grants and conveys to Grantee a temporary, non-exclusive easement in, to and over the Easement Property to facilitate the construction of a new driveway and entrance to the Golf Course Property (the "Driveway Improvements"). Following the expiration hereof (i) Grantee will repair any damage to the Easement Property caused by its use thereof, and (ii) the Driveway Improvements shall be located exclusively on the Golf Course Property.
- 2. Term. The term of this Agreement ("Term") shall be one year from the Effective Date.
- 3. Permitted Use, Access.
- 3.1 Permitted Use. Grantee shall use the Easement Area for the construction of the Driveway Improvements.

- 3.2 Restrictions on Use. Use of the Easement Area shall be solely for the use by Grantee and its contractors and employees.
- 3.3 Compliance with Laws. Grantee shall use the Easement Area and conduct all of its activities under this Agreement in strict compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations.
- 3.4 Environmental Matters. Grantee shall not allow any hazardous materials to be brought over, upon or deposited on, in or about the Easement Property by Grantee or its contractors or employees.
- 4. Maintenance and Repair. Grantee will, at its expense, repair any damage to the Easement Property caused by its use thereof.
- 5. Indemnification. Grantee shall indemnify, defend and hold Grantor harmless from any liability, damage, expense, cause of action, claim or judgment arising out of (i) any breach of this Agreement by Grantee (including, without limitation, any breach of Section 3.4 above), and (ii) the use by Grantee and its employees, agents, contractors, customers, visitors and invitees of the Easement Property.
- 6. Exemption from Liability. Grantee acknowledges and agrees that Grantor shall (i) have no obligation to provide security for the Easement Property, and (ii) not be liable for any damage, injury or loss of Grantee's property unless caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Grantor or its contractors, agents, or representatives.
- Agreement, maintain in full force and effect comprehensive public liability insurance covering its activities hereunder with a financially responsible insurance company or companies licensed to do business in the State of Oregon, including coverage for any accident resulting in bodily injury to or death of any person or consequential damages arising therefrom, and comprehensive property damage insurance, each in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 combined single-limit coverage. Grantee's liability insurance policy shall name Grantor as an additional named insured. Grantee shall, prior to the Effective Date, provide Grantor with a certificate evidencing the foregoing coverage.
- 8. Breach of Obligations. In the event Grantee fails to perform its obligations under this Easement Agreement, Grantor shall, in addition to any other remedies afforded under Oregon law, be entitled to (i) terminate this Agreement upon ten (10) days' prior written notice to Grantee, and (ii) require such performance by suit for specific performance or, where appropriate, through injunctive relief.


RECITALS

- A. Grantor owns certain real property located in Clackamas County, Oregon which is more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Sandelie Property"). Grantee owns certain real property located in Clackamas County which is adjacent to the Sandelie Property, and which is more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto (the "Fritz Property").
- B. A well identified in the records of the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD") as CLAC 9317 (along with its associated pumping and electrical equipment) is located on the Sandelie Property (the "Well"). The Well supplies water for irrigation purposes to the Sandelie Property and the Fritz Property, pursuant to Water Right Certificate 50575 (the "Water Right") on file with OWRD and attached hereto as Exhibit C. The approximate location of the Well is shown as well # 1 on the final proof map included in Exhibit C.
- C. Grantor and Grantee desire to enter into this Well Easement and Water Use Agreement ("Agreement") to establish their respective rights and obligations pertaining to the access, use, operation, and maintenance of the Well and to establish other rights and obligations as provided herein.
- D. A separate well identified in the records of OWRD as CLAC 9316 and designated as well #2 in the Water Right is located at another location on the Sandelie Property. An exempt well identified in the records of OWRD as CLAC 8196 (deepened by log CLAC 52192/ID L03011) is located on the Fritz Property. CLAC 9316 and CLAC 8196 are not covered by this Agreement; Grantor has exclusive use of CLAC 9316 and Grantee has exclusive use of CLAC 8196.

WELL EASEMENT AND WATER USE AGREEMENT PAGE 1 E. CLAC 9316 and CLAC 9317 are also the designated points of appropriation for Permit G-16291, held by Grantor. The water use authorized by Permit G-16291 is *not* covered by this Agreement.

In consideration of the following mutual covenants, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Grant of Easement. Grantor hereby grants and conveys to Grantee an easement to that portion of the Sandelie Property that is 50 feet in width from the Well to the Fritz Property (the "Easement"): (i) to use and convey water from the Well to the Fritz Property through an underground pipeline; (ii) to enter upon such portion of the Sandelie Property over the location of the pipeline to install, maintain, repair, and replace the pipeline, according to the terms of Section 4 below; and (iii) to enter upon such portion of the Sandelie Property over the location of the pipeline to operate, maintain, and repair the Well, according to the terms of Section 4 below.
- 2. Location of Easement. The Easement will be located along the most direct, practicable route from the Well to the Fritz Property, beginning at the Well, 2050 feet south and 1560 feet west from the N 1/4 corner of Section 16, and running generally northeast to the southwest corner of the Fritz Property (the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, T3S, R1E), approximately as shown on Exhibit D.
- 3. Nature of Easement. Subject to possible termination under Section 15, the Easement and rights granted herein shall be perpetual and non-exclusive. The Easement and the obligations described herein shall run with the land and shall bind and inure to the benefit of Grantor, Grantee, and each of their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns. Grantor may also make any use of its property burdened by the Easement that is consistent with its current or future ownership of the Sandelie Property, as long as such use does not unreasonably interfere with Grantee's use of the Easement as provided in this Agreement.
- 4. Installation, Maintenance, and Repair; Cost Allocation; Utilities.
- effective date of this Agreement, Grantee shall install a new, separate pipeline to convey water from the Well to the Fritz Property ("Fritz Pipeline"), located as described in Section 2 above. Grantee shall be solely responsible for the installation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of the Fritz Pipeline. All work performed on the Fritz Pipeline shall be completed in a workmanlike manner, free of claims and liens. Until the Fritz Pipeline is installed, Grantor and Grantee will share the existing pipeline running from the Well to the Fritz Property, including sharing equally (50-50) the costs of any maintenance or repairs of the existing pipeline. Upon completion of the installation, maintenance, repair, or replacement of the Fritz Pipeline, Grantee shall restore the surface of the Sandelie Property to its previous condition.
- 4.2 Well Maintenance and Repair. Sandelie will maintain and repair the Well in a good and safe condition and replace mechanical components of the Well as needed ("Well Maintenance"). Fritz may, upon not less than 24 hours advance written notice, perform any necessary emergency maintenance or repairs to the Well in the event Sandelie is not available to perform such repairs. All work performed on the Well shall be completed in a workmanlike manner, free of claims and liens. Each party shall pay its share of the cost of Well Maintenance in proportion to that party's irrigated acreage served by the Well (Sandelie, 77%; Fritz, 23%); provided, however, that neither party shall commence any shared Well Maintenance exceeding \$2,500.00 in cost without first obtaining the verbal consent of the other party, which consent



WELL EASEMENT AND WATER USE AGREEMENT PAGE 2 shall not be unreasonably withheld. A party shall pay its share of Well Maintenance costs within 10 days of receipt of a written statement setting forth the amount thereof, accompanied by a copy of the third party bills or paid receipts showing the nature of the expenses in reasonable detail.

4.4 *Utilities.* Fritz shall pay 23% of all utility charges incurred and attributable to the operation of the Well for irrigation purposes. Fritz's share of the utility charges shall be payable annually and shall be paid by Fritz within 10 days of receipt of a written statement setting forth the amount thereof.

5. Use of Water/Measurement/Allocation of Shortage.

- 5.1 Use of Water. The Water Right authorizes irrigation of 51.5 acres in total—39.7 acres on the Sandelie Property and 11.8 acres on the Fritz Property, withdrawn at the rate of 0.32 cfs, up to a maximum volume of 2.5 acre feet of water per acre during the irrigation season of each year. Subject to Section 5.3 below, Grantor shall be entitled to withdraw water from the Well to irrigate 39.7 acres of land on the Sandelie Property and other property owned by Grantor, up to a maximum of 99.25 acre feet annually, and Grantee shall be entitled to withdraw water from the Well to irrigate 11.8 acres of land on the Fritz Property, up to a maximum of 29.5 acre feet annually. Grantee's use of the water from the Well shall be for irrigation purposes only and only in the locations authorized by the Water Right, unless a change in character of use or change in place of use is authorized by OWRD.
- 5.2 Measurement. At its own cost, Grantee shall install a totalizing flow meter on the Fritz Pipeline to measure its separate water use, and shall maintain the meter in good working order and keep a record of the amount of water used each month. Upon request, Grantee shall share its water use records with Grantor.
- 5.3 Allocation of Shortage. If insufficient water is available from the Well to supply Grantor and Grantee with their full rate and duty of water, the available water shall be shared by Grantor and Grantee in the following percentages:

Grantor 77% Grantee 23%

- 6. Curing Defaults. If either party hereto shall default with respect to any of its obligations set forth herein (including its maintenance obligations), the other party shall have the right to complete such work and seek reimbursement for the cost thereof plus interest thereon at the rate of 9% per annum, provided that the delinquent party shall have been given prior written notice and a reasonable opportunity not to exceed ten days to complete such repair work.
- 7. Indemnity. Each party shall at all times protect, indemnify, defend, and save and hold harmless the other party from all claims, demands, liens, charges, encumbrances, losses, costs (including attorney fees before trial, at trial, and on any appeal), and litigation arising directly or indirectly out of (i) any breach or default under this Agreement by the party; or (ii) liability for bodily injury or death or property damage resulting from any tort of the party.
- 8. Noninterference. The parties to this Agreement shall not unreasonably interfere with the use of the Well by any person entitled to do so under the terms of this Agreement, provided such use is in the manner and for the purposes contemplated under this Agreement.



- 9. Cooperation. The parties to this Agreement shall cooperate with each other in good faith and shall execute such further documents and shall perform such further acts as may be reasonably necessary or appropriate to carry out and accomplish the intent of this Agreement.
- 10. Notice. - 12. Severability. If any term, provision, or condition contained in this Agreement shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby, and each term, provision, and condition of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 13. Applicable Law. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.
- 14. Entire Agreement. This Agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties and any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this Agreement shall not be binding upon either party except to the extent incorporated into this Agreement. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts.
- 15. Termination by Grantee. Grantee may terminate this Agreement upon 90 days' written notice to Grantor; provided, however, that Grantee shall remain obligated to pay its share of any costs incurred prior to the date of notice pursuant to Section 4 above, and provided further that Grantee shall record a Termination of Easement ("Termination"), having first received Grantor's approval of the language of said Termination.






