

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE BEERS and ROGUE RIVER, OR 97537 KENNETH C. AND/OR DORA M. BAINES 9876 E. EVANS CREEK ROAD ROGUE RIVER, OR 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for DOMESTIC, STOCK AND IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1896.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WILLIAMS AND WHALEN DITCH - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 475 FEET NORTH AND 860 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 ACRES SECTION 11 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 15, 1978, and ALONG WITH THE UNMODIFIED PORTION OF CERTIFICATE 42921 NOT INVOLVED IN TRANSFER NO. 4037, supersedes Certificate 42921, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

An order of the State Engineer entered August 9, 1974, approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 23.5 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George Beers and recorded at page 32767, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4037

On September 7, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Kenneth C. and Dora M. Baines for approval of a change in place of use of water from Evans Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 42921, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of George Beers, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second from Evans Creek for irrigation of a certain 1.5 acres in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1896.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Williams & Whalen Ditch, from a point located 475 feet North and 860 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicantsherein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.5 acres in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended

under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to George Beers and recorded at page 42921, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicants herein.
