ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4040

On September 12, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by A. E. and Dedie Buckingham for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from North Myrtle Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 44047, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Myrtle Irrigation Company, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.004 cubic foot per second from North Myrtle Creek for irrigation of a certain 0.1 acre in SE¹₄ SW¹₄ of Section 14 and 0.2 acre in NE¹₄ NW¹₄ of Section 23, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 25, 1920.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 13.09 chains North and 0.46 chain West from the Southwest Corner of Henry Jones D.L.C. No. 48, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 14, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicants herein propose to change the place of use and point of diversion therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 0.3 acre in SE¼ SW¼ of Section 14, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W.M., from a point of diversion located 25 feet North and 1550 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 14, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W.M.
