

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4047

On September 15, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John E. and Mary J. Meyers for approval of a change in point of diversion from Applegate River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 32839, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Maude Kubli, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second from Applegate River for irrigation of a certain 2.5 acres in SE¼ SW¼ of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1908.

The authorized point of diversion, pursuant to completed transfer No. H-160, is located 2510 feet South and 3370 feet West from the Northeast Corner of D.L.C. No. 39, being within the SE¹₄ SW¹₄ of Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W.M. (Kubli Ditch).

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 60 feet South and 1450 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 26, being within the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of September 25; October 2 and 9, 1978.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point diversion under the subject right, located 1950 feet South and 1800 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 29, being within the SW4 NE4 of Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

The order of the State Engineer entered February 15, 1966, approving transfer No. H-160, provided for cancellation of the certificate of water right recorded at page 32839, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate confirming the change in point of diversion authorized; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered February 15, 1966, approving transfer application No. H-160; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.

Certificate of water right issued to Anna Mansfield and recorded at page 5557, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River for the irrigation of 7.0 acres in the SWA NEWA, 16.0 acres in the SEWA NEWA, 2.0 acres in the NEWA NEWA and the supplemental right for 9.0 acres in the NEWA NEWA, Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1918. The diversion point of record for the 9.0 acres in the NEWA NEWA is within the SWA NEWA of Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Certificate of water right issued to George Herriott and recorded at page 5558, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River for the irrigation of 6.0 acres in the NEW NEW and 9.0 acres in the NEW NEW of Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1918.

Certificate of water right issued to Karl E. By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered January 10, 1940, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Maude Kubli for the irrigation of 3.1 acres in the SEA SWA and 3.6 acres in the SWA SEA, Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1908, and 4.0 acres in the SWA SWA, 13.0 acres in the SWA SWA, and 16.0 acres in the SWA SWA, Section 23, and 26.0 acres in the NEA NEA, 24.0 acres in the NWA NEA, 10.0 acres in the NEA NEA, Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1866. This right was confirmed by certificate recorded at page 32839, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Certificate of water right issued to E. W. Kubli and recorded at page 21512, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms a right to the use of waters of Applegate River for the irrigation of 2.9 acres in the NW, SWA, 3.5 acres in the SWA SEWA and 15.6 acres in the SEWA SEWA, Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 30, 1954.

The water is conveyed to these lands by means of Kubli Ditch, the point of diversion being located 1950 feet south and 1800 feet west from the NE corner of Section 29, being within the SWA NEW of Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicants herein propose to irrigate these lands by means of a ditch, the point of diversion to be located 2504.7 feet south and 3456.7 feet west from the NE corner of Donation Land Claim No. 39, being within the SE4 SW4, Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Leon and Lola Offenbacher, owners of the land on which the new point of diversion is to be located, have filed a statement to the effect that they have no objection to the proposed change in point of diversion.

That the diversion works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
