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On March 11, 1971, Stuert F. Smith filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and Three Springs and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered August 27, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Tumalo Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, a water right was established in the name of Tumalo Irrigation District, tabulated in the name of Lee Allen, for the irrigation of, among other lands, 7.0 acres in NWW, NWW, Section 26, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 28, 1905, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 26508, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

These lands also have supplemental rights evidenced by certificate recorded at page 31412, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of water from Deschutes River, with a date of priority of 1905; certificate recorded at page 26050, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of water from Tumalo Creek, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and Three Springs, with a date of priority of October 29, 1913; certificate recorded at page 26051, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of the waters of

Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of April 7, 1911; and permit No. 27841 for the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of December 8, 1961.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom, without loss of priority, to 7.0 acres in NE¼ NE¾, Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 7.0 acres in NWW NWW, Section 26, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M., as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 26508, with a date of priority of April 28, 1905, together with the supplemental rights evidenced by certificates recorded at pages 26050, 26051, and 31412, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 7.0 acres in NEW NEW, Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1972.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial

use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo Irrigation District at the time certificate is issued to the District confirming other transfers within the District.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4049

On September 19, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Wilton Gordon Smith for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified in accord with the provisions of the order of the State Engineer entered May 6, 1971, approving transfer application No. 2498, a water right previously allowed by decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered August 27, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, in the name of Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District (now Tumalo Irrigation District) and tabulated in the name of Lee Allen at page 196, Volume 16, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 26508, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, now exists for the use of water from Tumalo Creek, with a date of priority of April 28, 1905, for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 4.0 acres in NE¼ NE¾ of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

Also, as modified in accord with the provisions of said order, the supplemental water rights evidenced by certificate recorded at page 31413, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, for the use of water from Deschutes River, with a date of priority of 1905; certificate 26050, Volume 18, for the use of water from Tumalo Creek, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, with a date of priority of October 29, 1913; certificate 26051, Volume 18, for the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of April 7, 1911; and permit No. 27841 for the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a priority date of December 8, 1961, now exist for the irrigation of, among other lands, said 4.0 acres in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.



The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 4.0 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 22, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held September 5, 1972.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
