- 11. The watermaster map shows the place of use corresponding in shape and size to the applicant's description of the lands as clarified in the table above.
- 12. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screen is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost-share funds.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2) and 690-380-2110(2)]

- 13. Water has been used within the last five years. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 14. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14301.
- 15. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).

- 16. The proposed point of diversion diverts water from the same source of surface water as the authorized point of diversion, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).
- 17. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 18. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 19. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of diversion and the clarification of the place of use of a portion of Certificate 30755 proposed in Transfer Application T-14301 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore it is ORDERED:

- The change in point of diversion and clarification of the place of use for a portion of Certificate 30755 proposed in Transfer Application T-14301 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 30755 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new point of diversion.
- 4. Water right Certificate 30755 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this Transfer.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (RED LILY POD) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (FOWLER OFFENBACHER DITCH).
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same source of surface water as the original point of diversion.
- 7. The Department does not have the authority to make changes to Decreed rights without an application for Transfer as described in OAR 690-380-2200.

- 8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 9. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.
- 10. The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.
- 11. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 12. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screen is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost-share funds.

- 12. Water has been used within the last five years. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 16. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.

- 17. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change in point of diversion and the clarification of the place of use of a portion of Certificate 30755 proposed in Transfer Application T-14301 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-14301 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in point of diversion and clarification of the place of use for a portion of Certificate 30755 proposed in Transfer Application T-14301 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 30755 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new point of diversion.
- 4. Water right Certificate 30755 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this Transfer.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (RED LILY POD) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (FOWLER OFFENBACHER DITCH).
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same source of surface water as the original point of diversion.
- 7. The Department does not have the authority to make changes to Decreed rights without an application for Transfer as described in OAR 690-380-2200.
- 8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 9. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.
- 10. The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.
- 11. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 12. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing

statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting
 the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably
 ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the
 Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the
 issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been

filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.

On August 7, 2023, the Department received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$1360.00. Receipt number 141362 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine if a fish screen is needed.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water from the new point of diversion until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.

If the land is sold before the application is approved, the buyer's consent to the application will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.

Additional remarks:

THE CURRENT PLACE OF USE FOR 55 ACRES OF THE 1888 PRIORITY C-30755 WATER RIGHT ON THE MARTIN PROPERTY (FIGURE 1) DOES NOT COINCIDE WITH WHAT IS DESCRIBED IN THE CERTIFICATE OR DECREE MAP FROM THE 1916 ROGUE RIVER DECREE (FIGURE 2). THE CURRENT PLACE OF USE DOES COINCIDE WITH WHAT WAS MAPPED IN THE INCHOATE DECREE MAP THAT WAS DEVELOPED COINCIDENT WITH THE ROGUE RIVER 1940 SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS (FIGURE 3). THIS DISCREPANCY HAS BEEN OBSERVED FOR MANY YEARS AND IS SHOWN IN AN HISTORIC DISTRIBUTION MAP FROM THE DISTRICT 13 FILES (FIGURE 4). WATERMASTER SHAVON HAYNES ADVISED PAST DISTRICT 13 WATERMASTERS HAVE HONORED THE PLACE OF USE DEMONSTRATED IN THE INCHOATE DECREE MAP EVEN THOUGH THE POU DIFFERS FROM WHAT IS DESCRIBED IN THE CERTIFICATE (PERSONAL COMMUNICATION, JUNE 9, 2023; FIGURES PROVIDED BY SHAVON HAYNES).

THE DECREE MAP DOES NOT ENTIRELY CORRELATE WITH THE ACREAGES LISTED IN SECTION 25 IN C-30755. THE REASON FOR THIS INCONSISTENCY IS UNCLEAR. IT IS NOTEWORTHY THE D-13 FIELD OFFICE DISTRIBUTION MAP IDENTIFIES THAT "DECREE IN ERROR ON LOCATION OF WATER RIGHT". THE DISTRIBUTION MAP ALSO QUANTIFIES THE IRRIGATED ACREAGE IN THE VARIOUS QUARTER QUARTERS IN THE POU.

THESE ACREAGE VALUES COINCIDE WITH THE CURRENT PLACE OF USE WITH A MINOR VARIATION OF THE SPLIT OF LANDS IN THE SE NW AND NE NW 1/4 1/4S (ORIGINALLY 19 ACS AND 5.5 ACS, RESPECTIVELY; REVISED TO 23 ACS AND 1.5 ACS, RESPECTIVELY). IT IS REASONABLE TO CONSIDER THE D-13 MAP WAS DEVELOPED TO IDENTIFY THE LANDS WITH SUFFICIENT SPECIFICITY FOR MANAGEMENT AND DELIVERY OF THE WATER RIGHT. THEREFORE, APPLICANT PETITIONS THE OWRD TO ISSUE A FINAL ORDER TO CLARIFY THE LANDS TO WHICH THE SUBJECT WATER

RIGHT IS APPURTENANT (O.R.S. 540.560; O.A.R. 690-380). THE PETITION FOR CLARIFICATION ONLY AFFECTS THE MARTIN'S PORTION OF THE C-30755 WATER RIGHT. THE SUBJECT 55 ACRES REPRESENTS 54% OF 2.55 CFS WATER RIGHT FOR THE 102-ACRE POU IDENTIFIED IN THE CERTIFICATE FOR TRACT NO. 1. THE PRORATA RATE FOR THE 55 ACRES IS 1.375 CFS (617 GPM).
