

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1, 2, 3, and 4 in the UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 76.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1069. The date of priority is AUGUST 28, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.95 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



On March 16, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by 12 H, Inc., for approval of changes in place of use and point of appropriation from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 30133, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Marvin M. McDole, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.95 cubic foot per second from a certain ground water aquifer for irrigation of a certain 2.9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 32.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 36.9 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 3.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.1 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.1 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W.M., with a date of priority of August 28, 1958. The authorized point of appropriation is from a well located South 9 degrees 3.5 minutes East, 661.52 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W.M., being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use from a certain 6.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 8.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 3.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 3.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 4.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W.M., together with the remaining 62.2 acres, by diversion of water from Well No. 1 located 3180 feet North and 1470 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 28, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28; Well No. 2 located 20 feet North and 1350 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 28, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28; Well No. 3 located 1270 feet South and 1350

feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 33, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33; and Well No. 4 located 1940 feet South and 1350 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 33, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, all in Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the East Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Umatilla County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of February 8, 15 and 22, 1979.

Mr. William S. Bartholomew, Hydrogeologist for the Water Resources Department, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new wells shall not exceed the quantity of water diverted at the old well under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by

the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the changes in place of use and point of appropriation are completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 30133, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

By transfer application No. 3904: change the place of use from a certain 0.2 ac in NE^{1/4} NE^{1/4}, 5.8 ac in NW^{1/4} NE^{1/4}, 4.0 ac in NE^{1/4} SE^{1/4} & 6.4 ac in NW^{1/4} SE^{1/4} of Sec 28 described by said certificate 26193 and irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.2 ac in NE^{1/4} NW^{1/4}, 4.0 ac in NW^{1/4} NW^{1/4}, 4.0 ac in SW^{1/4} NW^{1/4} & 4.2 ac in SE^{1/4} NW^{1/4} of said Sec 33, together with the remaining 48.2 ac described by said certificate 26193 by diversion of water from Wells #1, 2, 3 & 4, as located above.

By transfer application No. 3905: change the place of use from a certain 20.0 ac in SW^{1/4} NE^{1/4} & 19.95 ac in SE^{1/4} NE^{1/4} of Sec 33 described by certificate 26685 and irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 19.95 ac in NE^{1/4} NE^{1/4} & 20.0 ac in NW^{1/4} NE^{1/4} of said Sec 33 together with the remaining 39.95 ac described by said certificate 26685 by diversion of water from Wells #1, 2, 3 & 4, as located above.

By transfer application No. 4089: change the place of use from a certain 8.2 ac in SW^{1/4} SE^{1/4} & 7.1 ac in SE^{1/4} SE^{1/4} of Sec 28 described by certificate 45787 and irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 3.92 ac in NE^{1/4} NW^{1/4}, 3.73 ac in NW^{1/4} NW^{1/4} & 3.92 ac in SE^{1/4} NW^{1/4} of said Sec 33, together with the remaining 121.5 ac described by said certificate 45787 by diversion of water from Wells #1, 2, 3 & 4, as located above.

All persons interested are notified hereby that a hearing will be held at the county courthouse at Heppner, Oregon on April 4, 1979, at 9:30 a.m. All objections to the proposed change, if any there are, will be heard at said time and place. Any and all objections shall be prepared in writing. One copy to be served on 12 H, Inc., R1 1, Box 1824, Hermiston, OR 97838, and one copy filed with the Water Resources Department, Salem, OR 97310, together with a \$10 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATION MAY BE APPROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING. Administrative rules pertaining to the filing of a protest will be furnished by the Water Resources Dept. upon request.
