ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3906

On March 20, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by W-4 Ranch, by Howard Gable, for approval of changes in point of diversion from John Day River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate issued to Stewart Grant, et. al., and recorded at page 25244, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, describes a right which includes the use of water from John Day River, with a priority date of 1891, for irrigation of a certain 72.1 acres of land, being:

1.0 acre in NE4 SW4
29.5 acres in SE4 SW4
Section 6
32.5 acres in NE4 NW4
1.8 acres in SE4 NW4
3.8 acres in NE4 SW4
3.5 acres in SE4 SW4
Section 7
T 10S, R 26E, W.M.

The authorized diversion of water is through the Templeton Ditch from a point located 300 feet South and 690 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 18, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 18, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to the following:

Pump Station No. 4A: 750 feet North and 1700 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 7, being within the SE4 SW4 of Section 7, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, W.M.

Pump Station No. 5: 175 feet South and 1500 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 7, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 7, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 30; April 6 and 13, 1978.

Mr. Jerry Rodgers, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in point of diversion of water from John Day River, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the changes in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Stewart Grant, et. al., and recorded at page 25244, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
