The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

On March 22, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by David Cheney for approval of an additional point of diversion of water from Willow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 137, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Sarah Ewing, describes a right for the use of water from Willow Creek for domestic (stock use) and for the use of not to exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second from Willow Creek for irrigation of 31.5 acres in SE¼ SW¼ of Section 8, Township 2 North, Range 23 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897.

Water for said right is diverted, through the Ewing Ditch, from a point located 1160 feet South and 1000 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NE4 NE4 of Section 20, Township 2 North, Range 23 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to establish an additional point of diversion, without loss of priority, at a point located 1010 feet South and 792 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 23 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Heppner Gazette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 8, 15 and 22, 1979.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not

exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the additional point of diversion established on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 137, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
