ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3914

On March 27, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Richard L. Renken for approval of a change in point of diversion from Threemile Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 21270, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Virgil A. and Florence Edith Rawson, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second from Threemile Creek for irrigation of a certain 11.1 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W.M., with a date of priority of May 25, 1948.

The authorized point of diversion is located 450 feet South and 1300 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1720 feet South and 2190 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Dalles Chronicle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wasco County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 14, 21 and 28, 1978.

Mr. Thomas J. Paul, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Virgil A. and Florence Edith Rawson and recorded at page 21270, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VIRGIL A. and FLORENCE EDITH RAWSON

of Route 1, The Dalles, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Threemile Creek a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation 5.2 ac under Permit No. 18260 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1948,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second, 0.08

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Victor Trevitt D.L.C. No. 45, Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from March 1, to October 1, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.25-c.f.s. 0.08

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.4 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4
- 1.0 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4
- Section 15
- 0.2 11.3 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 11.1
- 2.6 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.17 c.f.s.
- Section 22

All as projected within Victor Trevitt D.L.C. No. 45 22 Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 21270, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 19, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3914.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.
