

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3926

On April 6, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Loyd Quimby and Howard A. Hansen for approval of a change in point of diversion from an unnamed spring branch, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 23409, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates; in the name of Byron K. Brown, describes a right which includes the use of water from an unnamed spring branch for domestic use for two families at certain house sites in the NE% NW% and SE% NW% of Section 11, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 21, 1946.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 550 feet South and 1050 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 11, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 11, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the house sites above described, propose to change the point of diversion therefrom and, without loss of priority, to hereafter divert water at a point located 10 feet North and 1050 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 11, being within the SE4 SW4 of Section 2, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Byron K. Brown and recorded at page 23409, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate of water right be issued confirming the change authorized herein and covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding.
