- 9. Temporary Transfer Application T-14591 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights within the boundaries of Columbia Improvement District. The district was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and indicated that the district did not object to the transfer.
- 10. The proposed places of use as described in Finding of Facts #4, 6 and 8, above, are appurtenant to lands described under Permits S-55061, S-54633, S-55401, and S-55192.

These permits provide for pre-planned (only) annual use of water from the Columbia River, tributary to the Pacific Ocean, within certain constraints and permissions as outlined in the permits.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

- 11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 12. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 13. The proposed changes would prevent the lands from which the water right is removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred rights, as required by ORS 540.523(7).
- 14. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14591 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary change in places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14591 are approved.
- 2. The former places of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2025 and 2026 irrigation seasons.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2026 irrigation season.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- 5. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 94871, 94873, and 94874 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.

- 6. The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 94871, 94873, and 94874.
- 7. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 94871 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 94871.

On December 20, 2024, the Department received your water right Temporary Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$1937.92. Receipt number 144440 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not *temporarily* use water at the new place of use until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands <u>from</u> which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land <u>to</u> which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.

(1) Provided that the proposed transfer complies with all of the provisions of this subsection and will not result in injury to any existing water right, a district with a manager may, for one irrigation season, temporarily transfer the place of use of water appurtenant to any land within the legal boundaries of the district to an equal acreage elsewhere within the legal boundaries of that district or temporarily transfer the type of use identified in a right to store water. A temporary transfer of the place of use may occur if:

- (a) The rate and duty, and the total number of acres to which water will be applied under the transfer, do not exceed existing limits on the water use subject to transfer.
 - (b) The type of use authorized under the water use subject to transfer remains the same; and
- (c) The land from which the water use is being transferred does not receive any water under the right being transferred during the irrigation season in which the change is made.
- (2) Provided that the proposed transfer complies with all the provisions of this subsection and will not result in injury to or enlargement of an existing water right, a district with a manager may, for one irrigation season, temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation combined with a change in place of use, change the point of diversion in the event that an emergency prevents the district from diverting water from its authorized point of diversion, change the point of diversion to allow for the appropriation of ground water or change a primary right to a supplemental right if:
 - (a) The land on which the water is to be used is within the district's legal boundaries established pursuant to ORS chapter 545, 547, 552, 553 or 554;
