Nesika Beach-Ophir Water District depends largely on Certificate 37549 for water supply across its service area. This Certificate has a single approved point of appropriation (POA) at Well-3. The District has moved away from the use of Well-3 and instead intends to use Well-2, located a short distance away and in the same alluvial deposit aquifer, as the primary source. This transfer seeks to add Well-2, as well as a backup well (Well-1) in close proximity to Well-2, as approved POAs. There are no proposed changes to the place of use or character of use.
