

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4174

On March 16, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by W. C. Rivers for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County, Oregon, entered May 1, 1911, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Tumalo Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, a water right was allowed in the name of Columbia Southern Irrigation Company, tabulated at page 139, Volume 1, for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 2.5 acres in the NE½ SE½ of Section 24, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of September, 1900, as now described by certificate issued in the name of Tumalo Irrigation District and recorded at page 31410, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

These lands also have supplemental rights evidenced by certificate recorded at page 31412, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of water from Deschutes River, with a date of priority of 1905; certificate 26050, Volume 18, to the use of water from Tumalo Creek, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, with a date of priority of October 29, 1913; certificate 26051, Volume 18, to the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of April 7, 1911; and permit No. 27841 for the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a priority date of December 8, 1961.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain other 2.5 acres in the NE4 SE4 of Section 24, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held March 13, 1979.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the
water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo
Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.






Water being placed on land belonging to Peter Knowles: 22 acres

We received your letter dated June 5, 1979, advising that the supplemental rights are to be transferred along with the primary right as proposed by transfer application No. 4174. The copy of the deed conveying certain property to Arthur W. and Beatrice M. Mastrud was also received.

We would like to request at this time that all of the pending applications being held for the Tumalo Irrigation District be held until September 10, 1979, or until such time as we can provide the additional required documents for completion prior to that date. 

On March 30, 1979, we received amended transfer application No. 4174 in the name of W. C. Rivers and supporting maps along with your letter of March 28, 1979.

I neglected to mention in my previous correspondence that, in addition to the primary right described by certificate 31410, the supplemental rights described by certificates 26050, 26051 and 31412 and permit No. 27841 are also appurtenant to the area to be divested of the primary right as proposed by transfer application No. 4174.

Since a supplemental right cannot exist without a valid primary right, it will be necessary to clear our records of the supplemental rights or transfer them with the primary right. If it is intended to transfer the supplemental rights with the primary right, I can add that information to the application upon receipt of your written authorization.

As mentioned in my previous correspondence, it will be necessary to submit a print of the deed showing current ownership of the property from which it is intended to transfer the water right.

I am resubmitting the transfer T-4174 (Rivers/Knowles) originally submitted to you March 15 and returned to us under cover of your letter of March 27.

In reviewing the primary certificates, I find that the information on the original application was for the SE% SE% of the referenced section and it is therefore incorrect. The information your letter provided is correct according to our copy of certificate #31410 and the remarks have been corrected accordingly.

I contacted the parties involved in the transfer and find that there is a mortgage in the amount indicated by the Mastruds in their letter authorizing the transfer to take place and have therefore changed the response to item 11 on the application to comply with that information. We apologize for the inconvenience caused you by the application not being more substantially verified before being submitted to your office.

Just recently having come on board, I am in the process of changing the accounting and other office procedures and will handle all transfers myself as of June. In the meantime, Mrs. Brown will be remaining with us on a part-time basis and I will attempt to work with her a little more closely on the items leaving our office to avoid work duplication by your staff.

We have ordered a planometer and are revising our entire transfer procedure to more effectively accomplish the work to be done. Both the Board and myself are aware that changes are needed in our transfer policies and we are taking steps now to make these changes. Your patience in the meantime is very much appreciated.

If it could promote our effectiveness, I would come to Salem to spend a few hours with your staff viewing the processes there. As a matter of fact, I have contacted other office managers of the various irrigation districts here in Central Oregon and we are having our first group meeting tomorrow night and plan to form some type of group. There may be others that would be interested in a field trip to the Water Resources Department and perhaps to attend some of the hearings regarding State Water Laws which I understand will be coming up in this legislative session. Perhaps you have some thoughts on this matter.
