

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4279

On August 13, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by James Richard Murray for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 45149, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of G.N. Weaver, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River for irrigation of a certain 2.4 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 7.7 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, both within Isaac Bailey DLC 40; and 2.6 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 within William Weaver DLC 39, Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 14, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 1060 feet North and 1080 feet East from the East Quarter Corner, Section 6, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 760 feet North and 780 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 6, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the News Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of September 20 and 27 and October 4, 1979.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 45149, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.





CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G.N. WEAVER

of Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon 97457, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of the irrigation of 99.0 acres

under Permit No. 19266 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1950 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Bailey DLC 40, Section 5, T30S, R5W, WM, 1,060 feet North and 1,080 feet East from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Steve Donaldson has remapped the lands covered by Application No. 24436 (certificate 24411). Transfer No. 3747 changed the POD for 3⁰ acres in Section 6. A transfer (No. 4279) is pending for a change in POD for 12.7 ± acres.

The final proof survey done Oct 11, 1956 apparently showed the DLC and maybe the 40 lines slightly off. The map by Steve Donaldson in July 1980 supposedly correctly locates these lines.

Therefore, I am proposing to allow T-4279 based on Steve's map, then issue a new remaining right certificate showing the properties for each DLC-40 as Steve has remapped.
