#### Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

#### **Applicant**

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On November 15, 2023, Randy Kruse filed an application to change the point of appropriation and place of use under Certificate 80626. The Department assigned the application number T-14354.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on November 21, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On April 29, 2025, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14354. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of May 29, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On May 7, 2025, the agent for the applicant requested a completion date of October 1, 2030, to provide enough time to drill the well and complete the new irrigation system pursuant to OAR 690-380-5140(3).
- 5. On May 15, 2025, the Department determined that the portion of acres involved in the transfer, described in the draft Preliminary Determination as 121.010, were rounded up. This would create enlargement, by increasing the acreage irrigated under the right if the transfer were to be approved. The Department determined that a revised draft Preliminary Determination should be issued to accurately describe the acres involved in T-14354.
- 6. On May 23, 2025, the Department sent a copy of the Revised draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14354. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter provided a deadline of June 23, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.
- 7. On June 9, 2025, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14354 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on June 10, 2025, and in the Lake County Examiner newspaper on June 18 and June 25, 2025, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
- 9. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

- 12. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 13. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14354.
- 14. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 15. The proposed point of appropriation develops groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized points of appropriation, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).

- 16. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 17. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 18. All other application requirements are met.

#### Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation and place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14354 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in point of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14354 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 80626 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new point of appropriation or the new place of use.
- 4. Water right Certificate 80626 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing the portions of the right not affected by this transfer.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (WELL "ON"), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 1, WELL 3, and WELL 4).
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 8. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of appropriation.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2030**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On November 15, 2023, Randy Kruse filed an application to change the point of appropriation and place of use under Certificate 80626. The Department assigned the application number T-14354.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on November 21, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On April 29, 2025, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14354. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of May 29, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, of this preliminary determination.

- 4. On May 7, 2025, the agent for the applicant requested a completion date of October 1, 2030, to provide enough time to drill the well and complete the new irrigation system pursuant to OAR 690-380-5140(3).
- 5. On May 15, 2025, the Department determined that the portion of acres involved in the transfer, described in the draft Preliminary Determination as 121.010, were rounded up. This would create enlargement, by increasing the acreage irrigated under the right if the transfer were to be approved. The Department determined that a revised draft Preliminary Determination should be issued to accurately describe the acres involved in T-14354.
- 6. On May 23, 2025, the Department sent a copy of the Revised draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14354. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter provided a deadline of June 23, 2025, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.

### Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), OAR 690-380-4010(2), OAR 690-380-2200 and OAR 690-380-2110(2)]

- 10. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14354.
- 12. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 13. The proposed point of appropriation develops groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized points of appropriation, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).
- 14. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 15. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

#### **Determination and Proposed Action**

The change in point of appropriation and place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14354 appear to be not consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-14354 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in point of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14354 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 80626 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new point of appropriation or the new place of use.
- 4. Water right Certificate 80626 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing the portions of the right not affected by this transfer.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (WELL "ON"), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 1, WELL 3, and WELL 4).
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.

  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2030**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.

10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

#### **Protests**

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting
  the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably
  ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the
  Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the
  issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and

- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

#### Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.

Notice Regarding Servicemembers: Active-duty servicemembers have a right to stay proceedings under the federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act. 50 U.S.C. App. §§501-597b. Miller (1986) describes the groundwater source as the main groundwater reservoir. That reservoir includes groundwater in different geologic units. The reservoir has three characteristics. First, the "natural" groundwater level changes less than 1.5 feet annually, indicating the system is highly modulated. Second, the 1980s potentiometric surface was approximately 4292 feet elevation amsl basin-wide with Silver Lake an exception. Third, the reservoir consists of numerous water producing zones in several formations, all having an essentially common potentiometric level, and all being very transmissive in general.





On November 15, 2023, the Department received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$3340.00. Receipt number 141926 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to our groundwater staff to determine whether the proposed well accesses the same source of water as the original well.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water in the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.
