To more efficiently use the authorized capacity of Certificate 50707 and reliably provide municipal drinking water for the City of Jefferson, this transfer requests 6 additional Points of Appropriation (APOAs). As described in this application, the City requests the option to appropriate the full authorized rate of Certificate 50707 (1.32 cfs) from each well, without exceeding the total authorized rate of Certificate 50707 when used in combination or by itself. Well 5, authorized under Certificate 50707 is also requested to be removed concurrently due to abandonment as documented by MARI-70653.




Additional remarks: The intent of this application is to add 6 additional POA's (Wells 6 - 11) to more efficiently use the full rate of this certificate (1.32 cfs) to reliably provide municipal drinking water for the City of Jefferson. The potential yield from a single APOA is uncertain, so the City may drill up to six APOAs (Wells 6-11) proposed as needed to appropriate the full rate of the water right. Whether groundwater is appropriated from one POA or a combination of POAs; the authorized rate of 1.32 cfs will not be exceeded.






