Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On October 3, 2024, Rattlesnake Creek Land Holdings, LLC filed an application to change the place of use under Certificate 36879. The Department assigned the application number T-14544.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 15, 2024, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On February 21, 2025, the Department contacted the Agent for the applicant regarding inconsistencies in the acreage listed on the map and map legend and the Table 2 in the application.
- 4. On February 24, 2025, the Department received a revised map and Table 2 to correct the inconsistency.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 5. On March 13, 2025, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14554. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter provided a deadline of April 11, 2025, for the applicant to respond and submit the required information. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 6. On June 9, 2025, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-14544 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on June 10, 2025, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14544.
- 11. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 12. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 13. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 14. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14544 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14544 is approved.

- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 36879 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new place of use.
- 4. Water right Certificate 36879 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.
- 5. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 8. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. Hello Scott,

I am the caseworker for T-14544. There are a couple of deficiencies on the map and Table 2 from the application. I will need an amended map and Table 2 before I can move forward with processing this transfer. I am attaching a marked-up map and Table 2 to this email with the specifics of the corrections needed. Below I will give a brief description of the issues:

- 1. Map There is a 0.4 acre difference in the map legend and the actual amount of acres shown in the map
- 2. Table 2 The entirety of the acres for the right (certificate 36879) are included on the table. We just need the portion of the right to be changed, in this case it needs to be changed from 218.4 acres (entirety) to 73.2 (acres to be changed).






