





On May 30, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Edward Zedwick for approval of a change in point of diversion from South Fork John Day River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 25491, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Gaynor E.B. Campbell-Martin, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 1/40th cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion, for irrigation of a certain 3.0 acres in SW4 SW4 of Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 27 East, W. M., with a date of priority of January 11, 1897.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Dayville Ditch, from a point located 700 feet North and 1400 feet West from the E^{1}_{4} Corner of Section 12, being within the SW^{1}_{4} NE $^{1}_{4}$ of Section 12, Township 13 South, Range 26 East, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 330 feet North and 1250 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 6, being within the SW4 SW4 of Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 27 East, W. M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 12, 19, and 26, 1979.

Mr. Jerry Rodgers, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 25491, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

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

Dear Mr. Zedwick:

Your water right transfer application for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Fork John Day River, together with supporting maps and fees of \$85, was received May 30, 1979. Our receipt No. 11175 is enclosed.

Will you please review the location of the present authorized point of diversion for the water right involved? According to the map made in connection with the John Day River adjudication, the present authorized point of diversion would be located upstream from the old point of diversion shown on your supporting map at a point 700 feet N and 1400 feet W from the E¹/₄ Corner of Section 12, being within the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 12, T 13S, R 26E, W.M. A print of a portion of the John Day River adjudication map is enclosed.
