ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 4240

On June 12, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glenn Orval Lewman for approval of an additional point of diversion, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 47910, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glenn Orval Lewman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second from Williams Creek for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 12.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Shoudy D.L.C. No. 38, Section 23; and 10.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1858.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 650 feet South and 1820 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Shoudy D.L.C No. 38, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to establish an additional point of diversion, without loss of priority, for irrigation of the above described lands, from a point located 380 feet South and 630 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 26, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M. (Little Williams Ditch).

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 11, 18 and 25, 1979.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right and shall not exceed the amount of water available at the original points of diversion into the Baltimore Ditch, and shall not exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

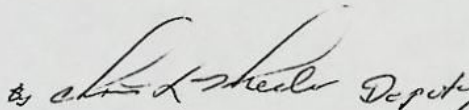
That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the additional point of diversion is established.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 47910, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Rights Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

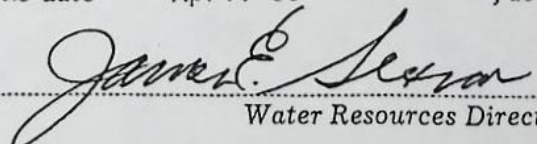

Your amended water right transfer application No. 4240 and additional water right transfer application, which has been filed as No. 4244, were received June 21, 1979, along with the supporting map and additional fees of \$35. Our receipt No. 12184 is enclosed.

In reviewing our records relative to the rights involved in your transfer applications, I found that the points of diversion authorized for the rights are located at different points than described in items No. 6 on your applications. The points described in your applications are the points allowed by approval of your earlier transfer application, but as a result of a survey by representatives of this office, the pumping plant site was found to be located 650 ft. S. & 1820 ft. W. from the NE Corner of Shoudy DLC No. 38, and the diversion point for Little Williams Ditch was found to be located 380 ft. S & 630 ft. W. from the Center Corner of Section 26. For your review, prints of the related final proof survey map and certificates 47910 and 47913 are enclosed.

I am enclosing both of your transfer applications and supporting map so that you may make the necessary corrections. I apologize for not bringing this to your attention in my earlier correspondence.

Your water right transfer application for approval of additional points of diversion from Williams Creek, together with supporting data and fees of \$80, was received June 12, 1979. Our receipt No. 11760 is enclosed.

Since changes are proposed for two water rights and the proposed changes are not the same for each right, it will be necessary to submit separate applications for each right involved. This may be accomplished by deleting information relative to the right described by certificate 47913 from the application submitted, and by supplying this information relative to certificate 47913 on the enclosed blank application form. The map submitted will suffice for both applications, but the additional application will require the examination and recording fees of \$35.

I am enclosing your transfer application and map. Please refer any correspondence to file No. T-4240. When you resubmit your application, will you also advise us which newspaper you prefer that we use that is printed and has general circulation in Josephine County where the water right is located.

The Water Resources Director of Oregon has received and filed two applications by Glenn Orval Lewman for approval, without loss of priority, of additional points of diversion of water under certain water rights.

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By transfer application 4240, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion for irrigation of the lands above described by certificate 47910 at the point of diversion for the Little Williams Ditch, located 380 ft S & 630 ft W from the Center Corner of Sec 26, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 26, T 38S, R 5W, WM.

The certificate recorded at page 47913 of said volume, in the name of Glen Orval Lewman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.72 c.f.s. from West Fork Williams Cr., under a priority date of April 19, 1950, for irrigation of a certain 9.2 ac in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 2.7 ac in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 23; and 17.0 ac in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 24, T 38S, R 5W, WM. The authorized point of diversion for this right is located at the point of diversion for the Little Williams Ditch as located above.

By transfer application 4244, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion for irrigation of the lands above described by certificate 47913 at the pumping site as located above.

Pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), a hearing is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, August 30, 1979, at the Josephine County Courthouse, Grants Pass, Oregon. Any objection to the proposed additional points of diversion must be prepared in writing: one copy to be served on the applicant at 17601 Williams Hwy, Grants Pass, OR 97526; and one copy filed in the office of the Water Resources Director, Salem, OR 97310, together with a \$10 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. Rules for filing objections will be furnished upon request.

IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATIONS MAY BE APPROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING.

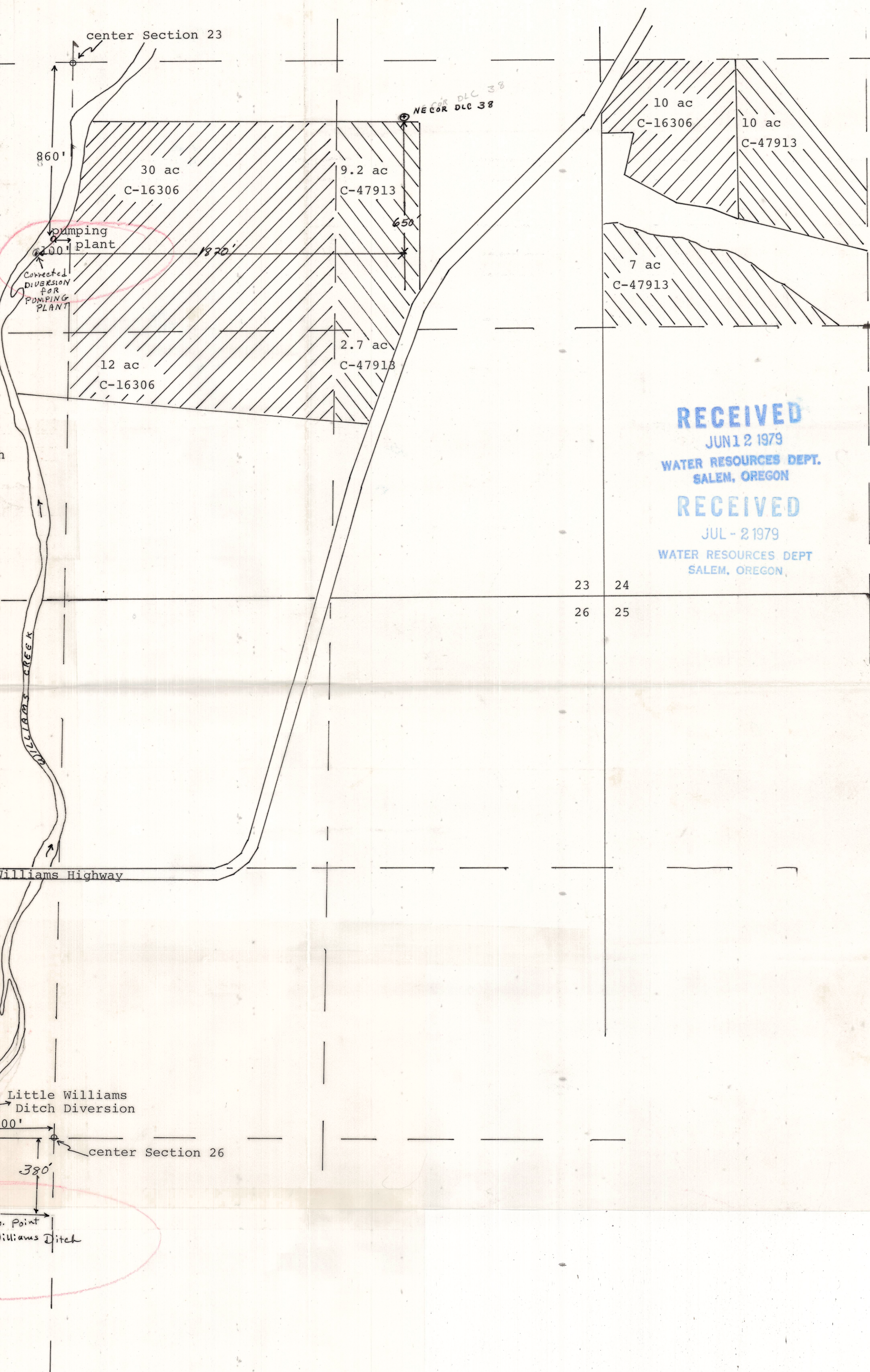
