

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4244

On June 21, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glenn Orval Lewman for approval of an additional point of diversion, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 47913, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glenn Orval Lewman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.72 cubic foot per second from West Fork Williams Creek for irrigation of a certain 9.2 acres in NE4 SE4, 2.7 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 23; and 17.0 acres in NW4 SW4 of Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 19, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Little Williams Ditch, from a point located 380 feet South and 630 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 26, being within the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to establish an additional point of diversion, without loss of priority, at a point located 650 feet South and 1820 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Shoudy D.L.C. No. 38, being within the NE¹₄ SW¹₄ of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 11, 18 and 25, 1979.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed the amount of water available at the original points of diversion into the Baltimore Ditch.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the additional point of diversion is established.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 47913, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

The certificate recorded at page 47910, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glenn Orval Lewman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second from Williams Creek, under a priority date of 1858, for irrigation of a certain 30.0 ac in NW4 SE4, 12.0 ac in SW4 SE4 of Sec 23; and 10.0 ac in NW4 SW4 of Sec 24, T 38S, R 5W, WM. The authorized point of diversion for this right is a pumping site located 650 ft S & 1820 ft W from the NE Corner of Shoudy DLC # 38, being within the NE4 SW4 of Sec 23, T 38S, T 5W, WM.

By transfer application 4240, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion for irrigation of the lands above described by certificate 47910 at the point of diversion for the Little Williams Ditch, located 380 ft S & 630 ft W from the Center Corner of Sec 26, being within the NE% SW% of Sec 26, T%38S, R SW, WM.

By transfer application 4244, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion for irrigation of the lands above described by certificate 47913 at the pumping site as located above.

Pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), a hearing is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, August 30, 1979, at the Josephine County Courthouse, Grants Pass, Oregon. Any objection to the proposed additional points of diversion must be prepared in writing: one copy to be served on the applicant at 17601 Williams Hwy, Grants Pass, OR 97526; and one copy filed in the office of the Water Resources Director, Salem, OR 97310, together with a \$10 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. Rules for filing objections will be furnished upon request.

IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATIONS MAY BE APPROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING.
