- 1. On September 18, 2023, SHARON J. SMITH filed a transfer application for authorization of a historic point of diversion under Certificate 97008. The Department assigned the application number T-14328.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 26, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

6. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screen is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost-share funds.

Transfer Review Criteria (ORS 540.532 and OAR 690-380-2120)

- 7. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-2120(2)(a), evidence has been submitted that the actual, current point of diversion for the water right in question, as described in Finding No. 4, has been in use for more than 10 years.
- 8. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-2120(2)(c), the Watermaster provided a statement that to his knowledge there has been no complaint of injury due to the use of water at the actual, current point of diversion, prior to the transfer request.

- 9. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-2120(3), the Department provided the applicant a list of the affected water rights and a copy of the notice to be provided to each affected water right holder. The applicant has provided written proof of service of notice of the proposed transfer on all affected water right holders.
- 10. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- 12. The proposed change, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed change in point of diversion to reflect historical use in application T-14328 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.532, and OAR 690-380-2120.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change proposed in T-14328 is approved and effective immediately.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 97008 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificate 97008 is cancelled. Certificate 98320 will be issued to describe the change in point of diversion for the portion of the right included in T-14328. Certificate 98225 shall be issued to describe the portion of Certificate 97008 not modified by this order. Together, the new Certificates shall supersede Certificate 97008.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1).
- Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Prior to October 1, 2025, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of diversion with the exception that water rights issued to the Bureau of Reclamation, or an irrigation district (or similar entity) are not subject to this condition.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 6. Prior to October 1, 2026, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.



APPLICABLE CRITERIA II.

To approve this application, the County must determine that the application is in conformance with Managing Development Within the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) Unit #5.

III. FINDINGS OF CONFORMANCE

1) Managing Development Within the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) Unit #5 page 5-18.

<u>FINDING/CONCLUSION</u>: This section provides discretion to the floodplain manager to exempt obviously insignificant activities from floodplain permit. Activities such as erecting a flag poles, planting a garden, farming, replacing a mailbox, painting or re-roofing a structure are considered exempt. Staff considers a removable irrigation pump as an insignificant activity because the project will not obstruct flood flows or alter drainage and will be removed between October and May.

- IV. CONCLUSION: The proposal to allow a removable irrigation pump in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) has been found to be consistent with Managing Development Within the (SFHA) Unit #5 page 5-18.
- V. DECISION: File 439-23-01572-ZON, an application for a Type 1 land use decision to allow a flood plain development permit on property described as Township 36, Range 3 West, Section 13, Tax Lot 1100/800 is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:
 - 1) Irrigation Pump Removal: The irrigation pump and irrigation lines shall be removed between October and May.
 - 2) Expiration: Pursuant to LDO Section 2.6.8 this approval is valid for four (4) years from the date of the final decision and will expire unless development has been initiated, as defined in LDO Section 13.3. This approval may be extended for an additional period not to exceed two (2) year on request.

This decision is limited to the County's review of applicable zoning rules and land use law, as outlined in the Jackson County Comprehensive Plan, the Jackson County Land Development Ordinance, and the Oregon Administrative Rules and Oregon Revised Statutes relating to land use. Other County, State and Federal agencies may have regulatory review authority for development projects. The decision rendered herein neither implies nor guarantees compliance with the requirements of any other regulatory agency. It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure that the development complies with the requirements of any other regulatory agency or provisions of law prior to initiating development.



STAFF DECISION: Approval with conditions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A. Lot Size: tax lot 1100/1.96 acres and tax lot 800/4.26 acres.

B. Zoning: RR-2.5

D. Access: Hardy Way

E. Areas of Special Concern: scenic resource

F. Overlays: Floodplain/Wildfire

II. **APPLICABLE CRITERIA**

To approve this application, the County must determine that the application is in conformance with Managing Development Within the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) Unit #5.

III. FINDINGS OF CONFORMANCE

1) Managing Development Within the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) Unit #5 page 5-18.

<u>FINDING/CONCLUSION</u>: This section provides discretion to the floodplain manager to exempt obviously insignificant activities from floodplain permit. Activities such as erecting a flag poles, planting a garden, farming, replacing a mailbox, painting or re-roofing a structure are considered exempt. Staff considers a removable irrigation pump as an insignificant activity because the project will not obstruct flood flows or alter drainage and will be removed between October and May.

- IV. CONCLUSION: The proposal to allow a removable irrigation pump in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) has been found to be consistent with Managing Development Within the (SFHA) Unit #5 page 5-18.
- V. DECISION: File 439-23-01572-ZON, an application for a Type 1 land use decision to allow a flood plain development permit on property described as Township 36, Range 3 West, Section 13, Tax Lot 1100/800 is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:
 - 1) Irrigation Pump Removal: The irrigation pump and irrigation lines shall be removed between October and May.
 - 2) Expiration: Pursuant to LDO Section 2.6.8 this approval is valid for four (4) years from the date of the final decision and will expire unless development has been initiated, as defined in LDO Section 13.3. This approval may be extended for an additional period not to exceed two (2) year on request.

This decision is limited to the County's review of applicable zoning rules and land use law, as outlined in the Jackson County Comprehensive Plan, the Jackson County Land Development Ordinance, and the Oregon Administrative Rules and Oregon Revised Statutes relating to land use. Other County, State and Federal agencies may have regulatory review authority for development projects. The decision rendered herein neither implies nor guarantees compliance with the requirements of any other regulatory agency. It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure that the development complies with the requirements of any other regulatory agency or provisions of law prior to initiating development.


