Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.570 to 540.580 establish the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 20, 2024, Jordan Valley Irrigation District (JVID) filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificate 75583. The Department assigned the application number T-14487.
- 2. Notice of the District Permanent Transfer Application was published on July 2, 2024, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On July 17, 2024, the applicant's agent amended the application by submitting a correcting map and authorized place of use table to correct scrivener's errors.
- 4. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 75583 in the name of JORDAN VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT (perfected under

Permit S-10843)

Use: PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 59.5 ACRES

Priority Date: SEPTEMBER 16, 1909

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.0 ACRE-

This final order in a contested case and is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075(2) and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Within 20 days after this final order is issued (i.e., mailing date), the district or any protestant may file with the commission exceptions to the final order. The commission shall issue an order granting or denying the exceptions within 30 days after receiving the exceptions. ORS 540.580(10).

- 6. The Department finds that the district permanent transfer application was submitted according to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OARs 690-385-4200 and 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OARs 690-385-4300 and 690-385-2200.
- 7. The Department finds that the proposed district permanent transfer meets all the criteria set forth in ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000.
- 8. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17),
- 9. The proposed change in place of use will not result in enlargement of the right as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(4).
- 10. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(6).
- 11. Any other applicable requirements for district permanent water right transfers are met as required in OAR 690-385-4500.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed change in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-14487 complies with and satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed change in place of use to the water right evidenced by Certificate 75583 is approved.
- 2. The place of use from which the water right is transferred off by Transfer T-14487 shall no longer be irrigated and is cancelled from Certificate 75583.
- 3. The right to the use of the water at the place of use NOT modified by this order is restricted to beneficial and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 75583.
- 4. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

- 5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2025**. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by JVID to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. Water right Certificate 75583 is modified. After satisfactory proof of completion has been determined by the Department, a superseding water right certificate will be issued when the Department determines it is necessary for record keeping.







Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On October 17, 2007, Jordan Valley Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificate 75583. The Department assigned the application number T-10472.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 23, 2007, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 75583 in the name of JORDAN VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT (perfected under Permit S-10843)

Use: IRRIGATION of 40.8 ACRES Priority Date: SEPTEMBER 16, 1909

Limit/Duty: ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second (CFS), or its equivalent, and 2.0 ACRE FEET per acre irrigated prior to JUNE 1 of each year and thereafter 0.5 ACRE-FOOT per acre irrigated per month during the irrigation season of each year, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE 258.5 ACRES FOR WHICH W.S. SKINNER (NOW SKINNER RANCHES, INC.) WAS DECREED A RIGHT IN SKINNER-VS-JORDAN VALLEY

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-385-4000]

- 5. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000. contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- The water right is subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 7. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the right.

- 8. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10472.

Conclusions of Law

The permanent change in place of use proposed in application T-10472 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The permanent change in place of use proposed in application T-10472 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 75583 and any related decree.
- 3. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 4. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 5. The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 6. The approved change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2009.
- 7. A Claim of Beneficial Use and Final Proof Map shall be submitted by Jordan Valley Irrigation District to the Department by October 1, 2010.
- 8. Water right Certificate 75583 is modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.





