



On January 8, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by George and Jerry Bulow for approval of a change in place of use and point of appropriation from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 41878, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of George S. Bulow, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second from a well, under a priority date of March 6, 1959, for irrigation of a certain 9.7 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 4.2 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 2.4 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 2.7 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 28.9 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 35.5 acre in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 1.6 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 0.2 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, Township 3, North, Range 26 East, W.M.

The authorized point of diversion is located 840 feet South and 430 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, W.M.

The applicants propose to sever the right therefrom and to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 18.4 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 12.8 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and 7.9 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 4, from the aforesaid authorized point of appropriation, together with 23.0 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 23.1 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, from a well located 1390 feet North and 2390 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 4, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Gazette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 1, 8 and 15, 1980.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water appropriated at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the appropriating of water at the new point of appropriation as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of appropriation of water made on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 41878, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, And upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.

Gentlemen:

I am enclosing your transfer applications Nos. 4118 and 4119, together with the supporting maps. The acreage listings in items Nos. 8 and 13 on the applications are not in agreement with the acreage noted on the supporting maps and some of the areas shaded on the maps are not in agreement with the number of acres noted.

For example: Item No. 8 on application No. 4118 lists 5.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  to be divested of the right while the map notes 3.0 acres and the area to be divested of the right in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, according to the area shaded is only about 1.0 acre instead of the 2.0 acres noted.

Rather than attempt to transfer parts of the rights to new locations to complete the circles you wish to irrigate, it may be best to prepare a single map showing the lands you wish to have under each water right; list in items No. 8 on each application the entire acreage under each right; and complete items No. 13 by listing the acreages to be covered by each right. Filing in this manner will require additional recording fees, but it may simplify the matter.

As mentioned in my earlier correspondence, it will be necessary for you to submit a statement from Prudential Insurance, holder of the mortgage, advising that they are in agreement with your proposed changes.

Your two water right transfer applications for approval of changes in place of use and point of appropriation from ground water, together with supporting maps, were received January 2, 1979. The fees in the total amount of \$131 were received January 8, 1979. Our receipts No. 8399 and 8400 are enclosed.

I am returning your two transfer applications with the four supporting maps along with a copy of this letter to Mr. William I. Porfily, our representative for your area. It will be necessary to make some corrections on the applications and maps. I have discussed this with Mr. Porfily and he will contact you in regard to any corrections or additions.

The proposed results, as indicated on your applications, are not, in all cases, in agreement with the intended results shown on the supporting maps. I have attached in the applications prints of our plat cards of Section 4, T 3N, R 26E, W.M., to which I have added information to show the variance.


