The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to continue the use of Well #2, as described above, as a point of appropriation under the said water right and to also use existing Well #3, located 30 feet South and 30 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NE¼ SE¾ of Section 18, being within the NE¾ SE¾ of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 26 East, W. M., as an additional point of appropriation from the said certain groundwater aquifer, under the said water right. (Said Well #3 is designated as Well #63 in Water Resources Department Groundwater Report No. 24.)

Notice of the application was published, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), in the Heppner Gazette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 1, 8 and 15, 1979.

Mr. William S. Bartholomew, Groundwater Geologist, Water Resources Department, has determined that if Well #2 and Well #3 were to be pumped simultaneously to obtain water under the provisions of the said water right, an increased interference with the wells of neighboring land owner-appropriators would result. However, it was also determined that if Well #2 and Well #3 were to be operated as alternate points of appropriation of water under the said water right, pumping only one of the wells at a time, the difference in interference with the wells of neighboring land owner-appropriators would be negligible as compared with the continued use of Well #2, only.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation, to allow the use of Well #3 as an alternate point of appropriation of water under the said water right, may be made without injury to existing water rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation is approved for the use of said Well #3 as an alternate point of appropriation of water under the subject water right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Said Well #2 and Well #3 shall not be pumped simultaneously to obtain water under the provisions of the above described water right; and that the water pumped from Well #3 shall not exceed the rate of flow available from Well #2, and shall not exceed a maximum rate of 4.13 cubic feet per second of water.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of appropriation is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Far West Farms - Oregon Ltd., and recorded at page 43929, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu therof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

On September 20, 1983 I inspected the Sand Hollow Pipeline project near Boardman. I did not attempt to contact anyone.

The project is a pump station on the Columbia Improvement District's canal, about 7 1/2 miles of various size pipeline, a reservoir and pump station, on farm pipeline and 24 center pivots.

I inspected the two pump stations and it did not appear they had been used in 1983. The reservoir was dry.

Gerald Rea's portion was being farmed in alfalfa, mint, strawberries, and grain. Irrigation water appeared to come from his well.

The majority of the land on Boardman Farms' west portion appeared dry due to the PIK program. Pivot #15 has asparagus. A couple of others were in use to establish fall grain crops.

On the east side of the road, pivots 6 and 7 are also asparagus. Pivot 9 has been removed and all bench land north and east of the road in Section 7 (about \$160 acres) has been planted to grapes and are irrigated by trickle irrigation.

Several pivots on the east side are planted to forage of some type with grass, alfalfa or turnips. The pivot south of well #2 has about 300 head of steers now grazing.

The farm appeared well managed, clean, and in good condition. Other than the canal and reservoir pumps, the irrigation system was in use, probably from the three wells.

### MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Far West Farms, Inc., Transfer Applications Nos. 4159 and 4160

No protest against approval of these applications for additional point of appropriation from ground water was filed within the statutory time limit and no notice was given to the applicant that a hearing would be held regardless of whether protests were filed; therefore, the applicants were not on notice to be prepared for a hearing to show that the proposed changes can be made in such a manner that injury would not result to other appropriators from the same aquifer. This having come to my attention during the late afternoon of Monday, April 23, there was no practical way to give notice of postponement of the hearing date.

Certificate 34928 describes a right for appropriation of 4.13 cfs under a priority date of August 7, 1967 from well No. 1, located within the NW $^1_4$  SE $^1_4$  of Section 20, T 2N, R 26E, for irrigation of a certain 2,240.4 acres.

By transfer application No. 4159, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of appropriation under the said right, being well No. 63 in the  $NE_4^{I}$  of Section 18.

Certificate 43929 describes a right to appropriate not to exceed 4.13 cfs under a priority date of February 10, 1969 from well No. 2, located within the NW $_4$  NE $_4$  of Section 17, said township and range, for supplemental irrigation of the same certain 2,240.4 acres.

By transfer application No. 4160, the applicant proposes to establish an additional point of appropriation under the said right, also being well No. 63 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18.

Questions to be addressed by the Ground Water Division are:

- (a) Do wells No. 1, No. 2, and No. 63 all develop water from the same aquifer?
- (b) If the wells were operated in various combinations with well No. 63 being used, at times, to develop the entire 4.13 cfs of 1967 water plus the entire 4.13 cfs of 1969 water, would this result in interference with wells of other appropriators beyond the interference now experienced by the other appropriators as a result of pumping wells Nos. 1 and 2?

I am advised by Al Petska that Mr. Dick Hilsenkopf understands that the 1967 right is limited to a rate of 4.13 cfs and that the 1969 right is limited to a rate of 4.13 cfs, and that approval of the applications would not, in any way, increase their authority to take water from any combination of the three wells in excess of a total rate of 8.26 cfs.
