### **Findings of Fact**

- On April 16, 1979, Vera Trivelpiece filed Transfer Application 4200 requesting to change the points of diversion for the water rights described by Certificate 38786 and Certificate 38787.
- 2. On June 28, 1979, the Water Resources Department issued an order, recorded in the Special Order Volume 32, Page 248, approving Transfer Application 4200.
- 3. On September 24, 1987, the Water Resources Department performed a field inspection to verify the new point of diversion approved by Transfer Application 4200. The field inspection revealed the change in point of diversion under Transfer Application 4200 was not completed.

### Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010, the point of appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion if the change is not completed.

On April 16, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Vera Trivelpiece for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from North Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 38786, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Vera Trivelpiece, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second from North Yamhill River for irrigation of a certain 2.5 acres in NW4 NE4 and 7.0 acres in NE4 NW4, as projected in D.L.C. No. 41 of Section 8, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of Auly 27, 1939.

The certificate recorded at page 38787, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Vera Trivelpiece, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second from North Yamhill River for irrigation of a certain 7.7 acres in SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and 9.2 acres in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 5; and 1.5 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and 1.6 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 8, all as projected in D.L.C. No. 41, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 14, 1938.

The authorized point of diversion for said rights is located 2370 feet North and 170 feet West from the Northwest Corner of McSween D.L.C. No. 80, being within the NW4 SW4 of Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 740 feet North and 90 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 5, being within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in The News-Register, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Yamhill County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 27; May 4 and 11, 1979.

Mr. Michael F. Ladd, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject rights.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.




I have a transfer application (7391) for a change in point of diversion. The point of diversion that is proposed to be changed has been authorized by Transfer 4200.






