confirms the right to use the waters of LOUSE CREEK, a tributary of JUMP OFF JOE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.4 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1859 FOR 0.01 CFS AND 1887 FOR 0.01 CFS.

The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION FOR MCDONOUGH DITCH.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 35 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1560 FEET NORTH AND 3450 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.4 ACRES SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 1979, AS MODIFIED BY AN ORDER ENTERED JULY 9, 1982, and together with certificates 51460 and 57557, supersedes certificate 37378, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

STATEMENT, FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS & ORDER

This proceeding was initiated by the Water Resources Director under the provisions of ORS 540.610 to 540.650 for the cancellation of certain water rights, based on information furnished to the Director alleging that the water rights in question had been forfeited by failure to make beneficial use of water under the provisions of the water rights for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse.

The water rights in question were allowed by decree of the court in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Various Claimants to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, in the names of W. J. Savage and G. M. Savage, for appropriation of waters of Louse Creek, through the McDonough Ditch, under priority dates of 1859 for 0.29 cubic foot per second and 1887 for 0.32 cfs for irrigation of a certain 4.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 10.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 3.0 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 20.0 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 5.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM; and 1859 for 0.20 cfs for the purpose "To carry waste material from saw mill in SE 1/4 SW 1/4" of said Section 30.

The aforesaid water rights were also described by the certificate issued to W. J. Savage and G. M. Savage and recorded at page 16512, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The said certificate was superseded by certificates recorded at page 37378, Volume 29; page 47814, Volume 41; and page 48020, Volume 41 of said record; and the Orders recorded at pages 680 and 681, Volume 31; and pages 560 and 561, Volume 34, of the Special Order Record (Exhibit WRD #1).



Protests against the proposed cancellation of the water rights in question, as said rights pertain to their properties, were filed by Hollis Gunter, John Beeler, Thomas Blanchard, Edwin C. and Virginia Edlefsen, and Jack Intlekofer within the time period specified by the notice pursuant to ORS 540.631.

Pursuant to the Director's Notice of Hearing dated March 23, 1982, the matter was brought to hearing at Grants Pass, Oregon on April 27, 1982, before James W. Carver, Jr., an employee of the Water Resources Department, authorized to preside in behalf of the Director.

Proponents of cancellation, Robert W. Roark, George W. Newcombe, Rufus M. Hagar and Donald R. Dennis, appeared in person and represented themselves without the services of legal counsel.

Protestants, Hollis Gunter, John Beeler, Thomas Blanchard, Edwin C. Edlefsen and Jack Intlekofer, appeared in person and represented themselves without the services of legal counsel.

The relative locations of the protestants' properties, the channel of Louse Creek, and Donaldson Road are shown on Figure 1, herein. Figure 1 is prepared on a duplicate of the aerial photograph used and received as Exhibit WRD #4, using property line information presented on Exhibit WRD #5.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The map prepared by the State Engineer in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Waters of the Rogue River and Its Tributaries does not define the specific land to which the water right in question is appurtenant. However, the applicant's map received in support of Water Right Transfer Application C-114 filed on September 14, 1954 in the name of Alys S. Craig, then owner of record of certain lands which include all of the lands now owned by the several protestants, does specifically locate the pertinent portions of the water right in question (Exhibit WRD #2).

With reference to the lands now owned by the several protestants, specific testimony of the several witnesses does not go back beyond the fall of 1975. However, testimony established that substantial portions of the subject lands are, or have been in recent years, covered with trees, brush, and herbaceous plants not susceptible to beneficial irrigation, and that certain other portions of the lands were used for pasture, garden and lawn areas.

After a careful consideration and review of the testimony and evidence adduced, including a June 8, 1975 aerial photograph of the lands in question (Exhibit WRD #6) and a June 19, 1980 aerial photograph of the same area (Exhibit WRD #4), the Director makes the following findings regarding the individual properties of the several protestants.

Hollis Gunter

Protestant is continuing irrigation on what were "open areas" of his lands. The said open areas which were covered with a "good thick duff of grass" when he acquired the property in December of 1980, covered a total of 3.5 acres. Since December of 1980, the protestant has constructed a pond on his property, which occupies approximately 0.7 acres of what was open area. Therefore, the total area which continues in irrigation under the provisions of the water right in question is 2.8 acres within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, as shown by yellow shading on Figure 1. The point of diversion for irrigation of these lands is the subject of Water Right Transfer Application 4705 in the name of Hollis Gunter.

The water right in question, as it is appurtenant to other portions of the Gunter property, has gone without use for a period of more than five successive years of nonuse prior to December of 1980.

John Beeler

Protestant is continuing irrigation of 1.4 acres of his lands, as shown by yellow shading on Figure 1, under the provisions of the water right in question. The point of diversion for the said 1.4 acres is the subject of Water Right Transfer Application 4115.

The water right in question, as it applies to other portions of the Beeler property, has gone without use for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1982.

Thomas Blanchard

Protestant is continuing irrigation of 0.3 acre of his lands, as shown by yellow shading on Figure 1, under the provisions of the water right in question. While diversion of water from Louse Creek for the said 0.3 acre has been from another location, the authorized point of diversion remains at the location of the head of the old, abandoned McDonough Ditch.

The water right in question, as it may be appurtenant to other portions of the Blanchard property, has gone without use of a period of five and more successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1982.

Edwin C. and Virginia Edlefsen

Protestants are continuing irrigation of 0.8 acre of their lands, as shown by yellow shading on Figure I, under the provisions of the water right in question. While diversion of water from Louse Creek for the said 0.8 acre has been from another location, the authorized point of diversion remains at the location of the head of the old, abandoned McDonough Ditch.

The water right in question, as it is appurtenant to other portions of the Edlefsen property, has gone without use for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1982.

Jack Intlekofer

Protestant is continuing irrigation of 1.2 acres of his lands, as shown by yellow shading on Figure 1, under the provisions of the water right in question. While diversion of water from Louse Creek for the said 1.2 acres has been from another location, the authorized point of diversion remains at the location of the head of the old, abandoned McDonough Ditch.

The water right in question, as it is appurtenant to other portions of the Intlekofer property, has gone without use for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1982.

The water right in question, with the exception of that portion of the right which is appurtenant to the certain lands of the several protestants as identified above and located as shaded with yellow on Figure 1, has not been used for the beneficial irrigation of the lands to which it is appurtenant for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse.

That portion of the said water right which is appurtenant to the certain lands of the several protestants as identified above and located as shaded with yellow on Figure 1, may have been forfeited by the occurrence of a period of five and more successive years of nonuse during some past period of years. However, the burden of proof is upon the proponents of cancellation, and that burden has not been met in regard to these lands.

In addition to the lands owned by parties receiving notice as set forth above, the water right in question is appurtenant to 3.0 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 10.0 acres in E 1/2 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, which land was owned by Lee Roy Lookabaugh and Billie J. Lookabaugh as of August 28, 1981.

On August 28, 1981, Lee Roy Lookabaugh and Billie J. Lookabaugh executed an affidavit abandoning the portion of the water right in question appurtenant to said lands and authorizing the Water Resources Director to cancel said portion of said water right.

The evidence adduced established that the saw mill in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 which was served with water from Louse Creek, through the McDonough Ditch, in the amount of not to exceed 0.20 cfs under a priority date of 1859 for the purpose of "To carry waste material from saw mill ..." has been gone for at least ten years, and that water has not been used under the provisions of the subject water right for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

I

That portion of the water right in question for the appropriation of not to exceed 0:25 cubic foot per second with a priority date of 1859 and 0.27 cfs with a priority date of 1887 from the waters of Louse Creek for irrigation of a certain 2.8 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 7.5 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 3.0 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 17.2 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 5.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, was not used for beneficial irrigation of said lands for a period of at least five successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1981.

II

The evidence adduced does not establish the occurrence of any period of five successive years of nonuse of that portion of the water right in question for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.04 cfs with a priority date of 1859 and 0.05 cfs with a priority date of 1887 from the waters of Louse Creek for irrigation of the certain 1.2 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 2.5 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, and 2.8 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, as identified by yellow shading on Figure 1.

Ш

No water has been appropriated to beneficial use under the provisions of the water right in question for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.20 cfs from the waters of Louse Creek under a priority date of 1859 for the purpose of "To carry waste material from saw mill in SE 1/4 SW 1/4" of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, for a period of five and more successive years of nonuse, and continuing to the present time.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

That the question before the Water Resources Director is one of fact concerning forfeiture of the water right, not one concerning abandonment, or voluntary relinquishment, of the water right, is made clear by Withers v. Reed, 194 Or 541 (p 558) wherein the court states in reference to ORS 540.610(1):

"Under the statute in question failure of 'the owner of a perfected and developed water right' to use the water appropriated for a period of five successive years works a forfeiture of the right not for the benefit of any individual as in the case of an ordinary statute of limitations — which this is not — but for the benefit of the public, to the end that the 'water right shall revert to the public and become again the subject of appropriation in the manner provided by law, ...'."

The court further commented in Bausch v. Myers, 273 Or 376:

"Urbanites might not know that the water rights are conclusively presumed abandoned for failure to use for five successive years. This law, however, is common knowledge among all in Oregon who are dependent upon an adequate supply of water for irrigation. We believe it is equally well known that five years of nonuse is a conclusive abandonment whether proceedings before the State Engineer are brought immediately after the five years of nonuse or 10 or 15 years later"

Beneficial use without waste is the framework of Oregon's water law (See ORS 540.610(1)). The elements of an appropriation are as stated in Hutchinson v. Sticklin, 146 Or 297:

- (1) Intent manifested to appropriate to some beneficial use existing at the time or contemplated in the future;
- (2) A diversion from the natural channel by means of a ditch, canal, or other structure;
- (3) The application of it within a reasonable time to some useful industry.

Mere application of water to lands without the intent of reaping a benefit from the nourishment of plants with the water would not constitute beneficial use.

No water was appropriated to beneficial use under the provisions of that portion of the water right in question for irrigation purposes, described in Ultimate Findings of Fact I, above, within a period of five and more successive years of nonuse prior to the beginning of the irrigation season of 1981. Therefore, the said portion of the said water right was forfeited and should be canceled pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.610 to 540.650.

No water was appropriated to beneficial use under the provisions of the water right for carrying away mill wastes, described in Ultimate Finding of Fact III, above, within a period of five and more successive years of nonuse. Therefore, the said water right was forfeited and should be canceled pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.610 to 540.650.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right in question for the purpose of irrigation, described in Ultimate Finding of Fact I, above, be and the same hereby is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the water right in question for the purpose of carrying away saw mill wastes, described in Ultimate Finding of Fact III, above, be and the same hereby is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 48020, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be and the same hereby is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the remaining right certificate to be issued pursuant to the Director's order dated May 27, 1981 approving Water Right Transfer Application 4705, be limited to describe the appropriation of not to exceed 0.01 cfs under a priority date of 1859 and 0.02 cfs under a priority date of 1887 from the waters of Louse Creek for irrigation of a certain 0.3 acre in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 on the Blanchard property, 0.3 acre in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 0.5 acre in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 on the Edlefsen property, and 0.9 acre in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 0.3 acre in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 on the Intlekofer property, all within Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that when a certificate is issued to confirm the change in point of diversion as authorized by the Director's order approving Water Right Transfer Application 4705 in the name of Hollis Gunter, the description of the water right be limited to describe the appropriation of not to exceed 0.02 cfs under a priority date of 1859 and 0.02 cfs under a priority date of 1887 from the waters of Louse Creek for the irrigation of a certain 2.8 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that when a certificate is issued to confirm the change in point of diversion as authorized by the Director's order approving Water Right Transfer Application 4115 in th name of John Beeler, the description of the water right be limited to describe the appropriation of not to exceed 0.01 cfs under a priority date of 1859 and 0.01 cfs under a priority date of 1887 from the waters of Louse Creek for the irrigation of a certain 1.4 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM.



On December 27, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John Beeler for approval of a change in point of diversion from Louse Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 37378, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of W. J. and G. M. Savage, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.029 cubic foot per second from Louse Creek, being 0.014 cubic foot per second for irrigation of 0.95 acre with a priority date of 1887 and 0.015 cubic foot per second for irrigation of 1.05 acres with a priority date of 1859, in the SE½ SW½ of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the McDonough Ditch, from a point located 100 feet North and 450 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 30, being within the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1520 feet North and 810 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 30, being within the NE_4^1 SW_4^1 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Rnage 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 11, 18 and 25, 1979.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.



NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.029 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 37378, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the terms of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.



I have your letter of September 13th submitting application on behalf of Alys S. Graig for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Louse Greek, together with map and check in the amount of \$10 for which our official receipt No. 2210 is enclosed.

From an examination of the Roque River decree it appears that W. J. Savage and O. M. Savage were adjudicated a water right as follows:

In examining the application it is noted that the applicant claims a date of priority of 1887 for 26 acres or 4 acres in excess of the total acreage having an 1887 priority. If Mr. Craig owns the whole 42 acres adjudicated a water right in the name of W. J. and G. M. Savage, then, of course, he can fix that part of the acreage having an 1859 priority and that part of the acreage having an 1887 priority. On the other hand the facts may show that some other party owns part of the lands and unless there is some agreement with respect to which lands have the 1859 and which lands have the 1887 priority, it would appear to me that the lands would have a proportionate share of each of said priorities involved, computed as follows:
