


ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4122

On January 10, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by James L. Heard for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches, and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified in accord with the provisions of the order of the State Engineer entered March 7, 1974, approving transfer No. 2924, a part of the water right previously described by the certificate issued to Tumalo Irrigation District and recorded at page 26050, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, now exists for the use of water from Tumalo Creek, supplemented by the use of water from Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and three spring branches for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 1.0 acre in SW4 NW4 of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 29, 1913.

Also, as modified in accord with the provisions of said order, parts of the supplemental water rights previously described by certificate recorded at page 31413, Volume 23 of said record; for use of water from Deschutes River with a date of priority of 1905; certificate recorded at page 26051, Volume 18 of said records for use of water from Crescent Lake Reservoir with a priority date of April 7, 1911; and permit No. 27841 for use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir with a priority date of December 8, 1961, now exists for supplemental irrigation of, among other lands, said 1.0 acre in SW4 NW4 of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 1.0 acre in SE4 SW4 of Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M. (Rash).

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held November 4, 1975.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.

I am attempting to do the final proof survey of water right transfer 4122 for land you own in Township 16 S, Range 12E, Section 19. This land is in the delivery system of the Tumalo Irrigation District.

The right in question is for irrigation. The date for the complete application of water was October 1, 1980. All land intended to be irrigated should have been completed by that date, and such irrigation continued so the right is not abandoned or forfeited.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to accomplish beneficial use under the terms of the transfer to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director. The final proof survey is the means by which proof is submitted to the Director.

On May 15, 1986, I visited your property and found no evidence of irrigation. If you have used this water right, I need a statement from you which provides the following information:

- When was the land first irrigated and how often it has been irrigated since then?
- 2. What crop was grown?
- The method of irrigation. If by sprinkler, the number and type of sprinkler heads, also the type and size of pump.

Intent is to attest to the use of his water rights, in good faith and intent according to the rules and regulations of the water district, as we know them.

The spring of 1984 saw much improvement to this property. I was involved (supervising) and did perform the task of clearing more land. All the land was harrowed and fertilized. The newly cleared area was also seeded. The manager of the Tumalo district at the time was Ron Reinhardt, who inspected the improvements to the property, was impressed and stated that it was obvious to him that a diligent effort was made and the fields did comply with agriculture use water consumption. Mr John Kiesow & I saw to it that the irrigation sprinklers ran 24 hours aday all season, up to the time the two ton crop of grass hay was harvested.

In the spring of 1985, the land was again harrowed, fertilized and irrigated to harvest of even a larger hay crop. Mr Kiesow, of Bend, Oregon, would have a record of the 84 and 85 harvest.

Dear Mr. Mattick

In reply to your letter dated May 16, 1986, I submit the following information as requested:

- This land was first irrigated on or about 1976 or 1977 by my neighbor, Ronald Parks, as he used the land for grazing and pasture of his livestock. This went on for several seasons until the grass was depleted by overuse.
- 2. Since the stoppage of grazing, a hay crop has been grown and cut by Mr. John Kiesow.
- 3. The method of irrigation has been by seven sprinkler heads, Rainbird # 30 with 9/64 x 3/32 nozzles on 12" risers delivery of 5.1 GPM at 40 PSI using a 3/4 HP submersible pump located in a 20,000 gallon cistern.
- 4. A sketch is not available, but a local person by the name of Dick Collver would be happy to give you any other details if needed. His phone number is (503) 382-5643.

I have attached his statement concerning the water and crop use.

I have also attached copies of power usage for your review, as there is no other equipment on the property except for the water pump to run the irrigation system. You can see the ups and downs of the power consumption.

Other various receipts are attached to show cistern installation, pump and irrigation pipe, sprinklers, wire, etc.

I have worked on this project with the Tumalo Irrigation District, in particular, Mr. Ron Reinhart, also Ralph McNutty.






