



By law, all water belongs to the public [ORS 537.110]. In almost every instance, a Permit OR Water Right Certificate from the **Water Resources Department** is needed before using, diverting; or storing water [ORS 537-130]. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the land. 




