Authority

OAR 690-385-7600 describes the process for the Water Resources Department to issue a water right certificate upon determination that an applicant has made satisfactory proof of completion of the changes authorized by a final order approving a district permanent transfer.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 30, 2007, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 73, Pages 711 720, approving district permanent transfer applications T-10245 and T-10314. The order established October 1, 2009, as the date for completion of the authorized change in place of use.
- 2. On January 13, 2010, the Department received claims of beneficial use for T-10245 and T-10314.
- 3. The Department reviewed the claim of beneficial use and final proof maps submitted by the applicant for district permanent transfers T-10245 and T-10314.
- 4. The claims of beneficial use did not contain map(s) of the point(s) of diversion from the source. However, since these changes are for place of use only within an irrigation district, and do not involve changes in point of diversion, the existing map(s) on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point(s) of diversion from the source.
- 5. Satisfactory proof of the changes was submitted with evidence showing that water was used in the location and for the purpose as authorized by the final order approving Transfer Application T-10245 and T-10314.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-385-7600, the Department may issue a certificate upon a determination that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving a permanent district transfer was completed to the extent authorized.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The Department has determined that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving district permanent transfer T-10245 and T-10314 were completed to the extent authorized.
- 2. Pursuant to OAR 690-385-7600, the Department will issue a water right certificate on a determination that it is necessary to produce a certificate describing the right.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 20. The district permanent transfer applications satisfy the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contain the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and include maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 21. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 22. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 23. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Applications T-10245 and T-10314.
- 24. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 25. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The permanent change in place of use proposed in Applications T-10245 and T-10314 complies with the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and ORS 540.580; with the exception that the petition for Application T-10245, as described in Finding #10 above, was not received prior to the end of the calendar year in which the change occurred as required under ORS 540.580(2).

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The permanent change in place of use proposed in Applications T-10245 and T-10314 is approved.

- 2. Water right certificates 74080, 74081 and 76212 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it is determined that it is necessary for record keeping.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74080, 74081 and 76212 and any related decree.
- 4. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2009.
- 6. A Claim of Beneficial Use and Final Proof Map shall be submitted by Vale Oregon Irrigation District to the Department by October 1, 2010.
