The holder of a water right may apply to permanently change an existing water use subject to transfer. A transfer application may involve any of the following changes: Point of diversion or appropriation (POD; POA); Additional point of diversion or appropriation (APOD; APOA); Historic POD (HIST); Place of use (POU); Character of use (USE); Instream (ISWR); Substitution (SUB); or Exchange (EXCH).

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.

The holder of a water right permit may apply to change a point of diversion (POD) or appropriation (POA) or to change the place of use (POU).

Any person who provides comments within the comment period will receive a copy of the Department's preliminary determination of whether the application should be approved or rejected after the Department has completed a review of the application and will be provided an opportunity to protest the application and preliminary determination at that time. The Director may presume that the transfer would be allowed by, and compatible with comprehensive plans unless an affected local government informs the Director otherwise within 30 days of this notice. This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-9583 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Troutdale of 104 Kibling Street, Troutdale, Oregon 97060, phone 665-5175, for the use of the waters of Well 4, for the PURPOSE of municipal use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 17, 1981 for 1.11 cubic feet per second of water and September 20, 1982 for 1.11 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.22 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 890 feet South and 545 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Multnomah.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a well, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. ~~Extended to October 1, 1989~~, 10-1-95, 10-1-2000

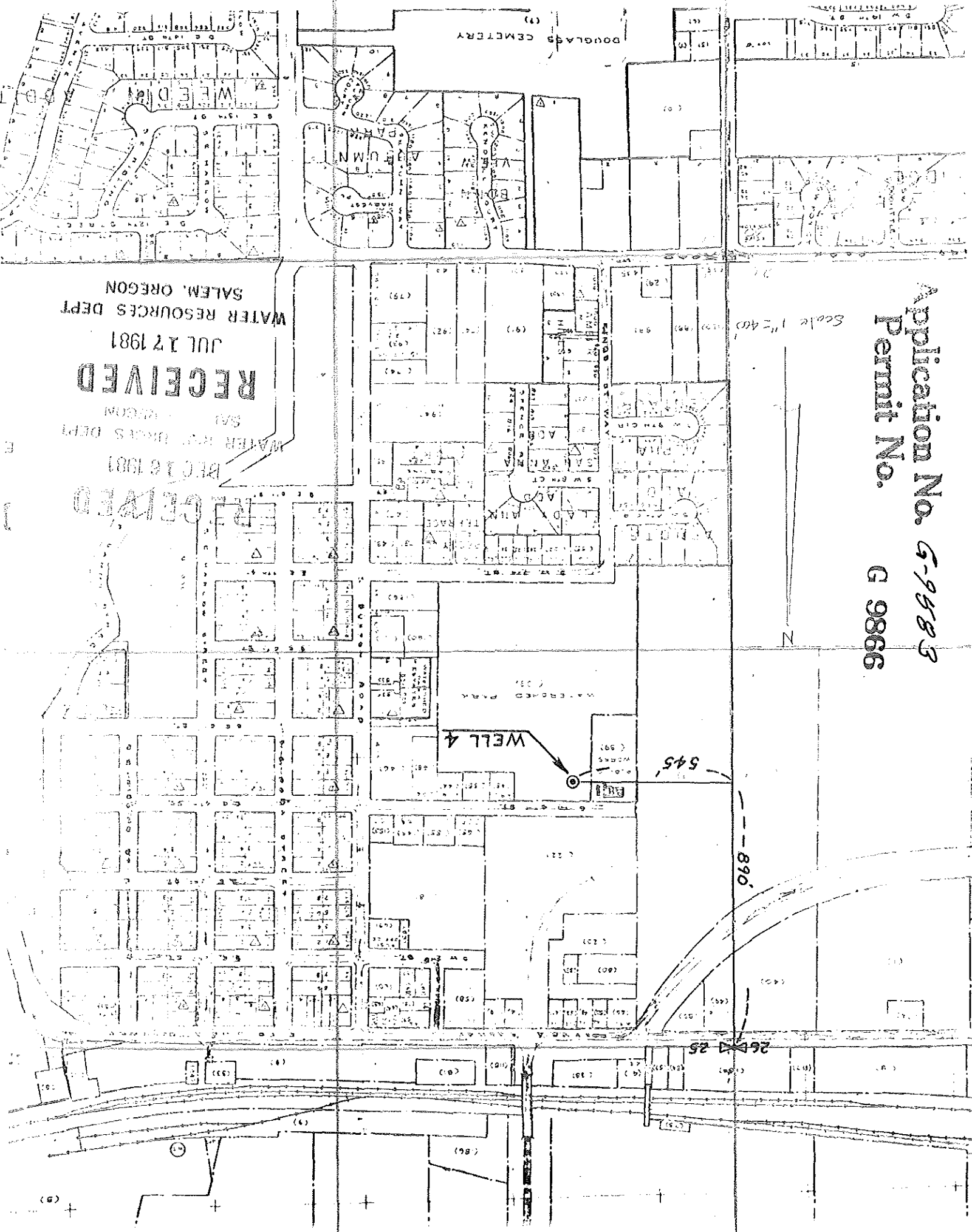

Could I get a confirmation on the proposed place of use of the permit amendment? The application seems to indicate that the proposed place of use would be within the city limits. However, the map shows areas outside the city limits and this could potentially impact areas controlled by Fairview and Wood Village. This could be an artifact of map drafting i.e. cross-hatchuring the entire quarter-quarter as the proposed place of use.

I have done some quick editing on the map (see attached) and perhaps this map more closely exhibits what was intended. If so, please instruct me to add it to the permit amendment application as an amended map.

If, however, you do wish to deliver water to the areas outside of the city limits in that area, then you would need to show agreement(s) from Fairview and Wood Village to have the permit used on areas that those municipalities control.

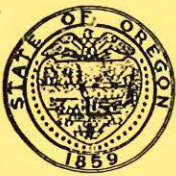

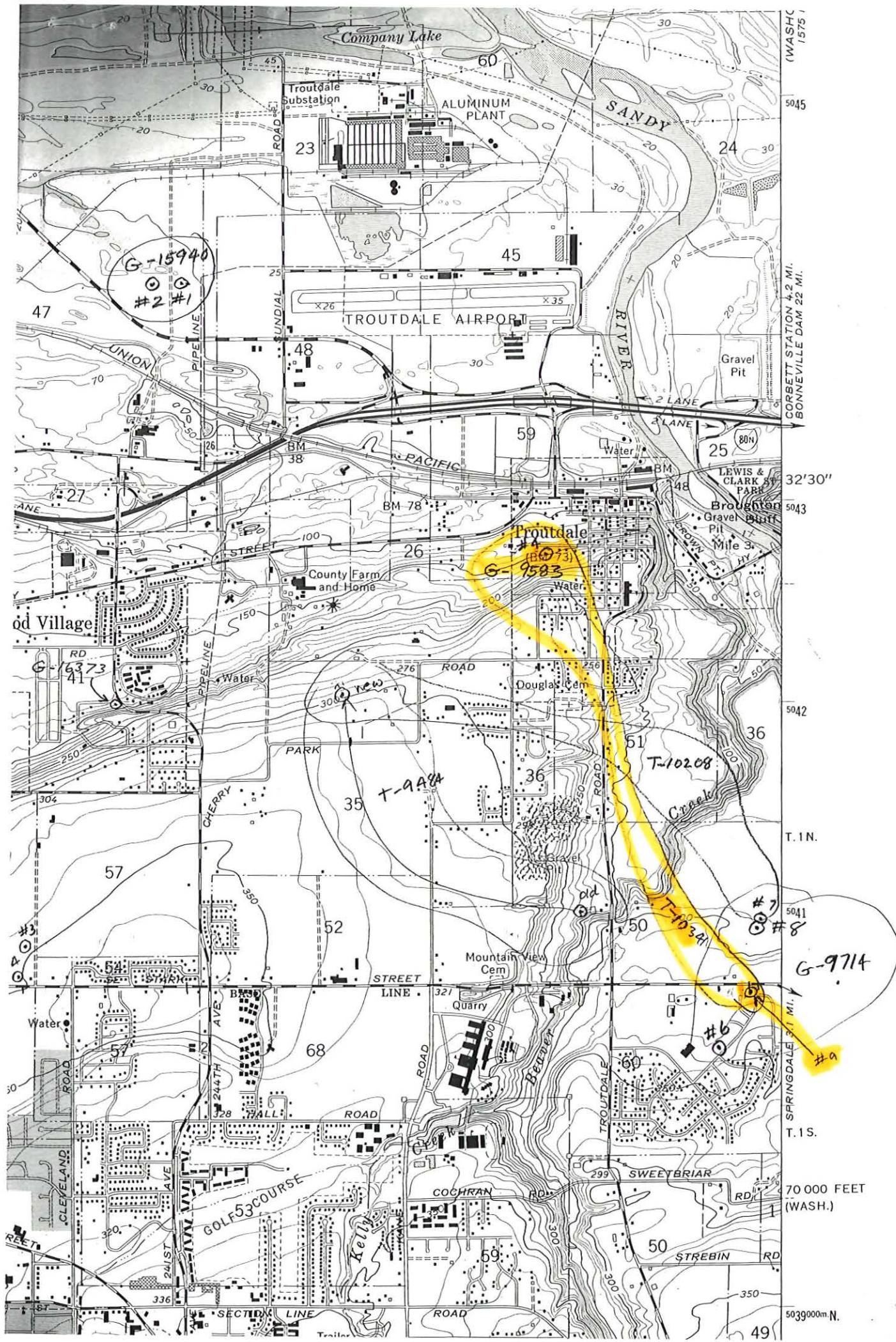

SUBJECT: Transfer Comments

Focusing on the change addressed by this review, the transfer seeks to add a POA (un-built well but with construction described) to an existing permit (G-9866). This would be a permit amendment. The authorized well on the permit is MULT 1340. It develops water from the Sand and Gravel Aquifer. The proposed well would also develop that aquifer based on the proposed construction and aquifer geometry per the USGS WRIR 90-4196.

The transfer should not result in injury since the aquifer is thick and the closest identified user is more than 1000 feet away. Full development of the resource should provide ample cushioning for interference.

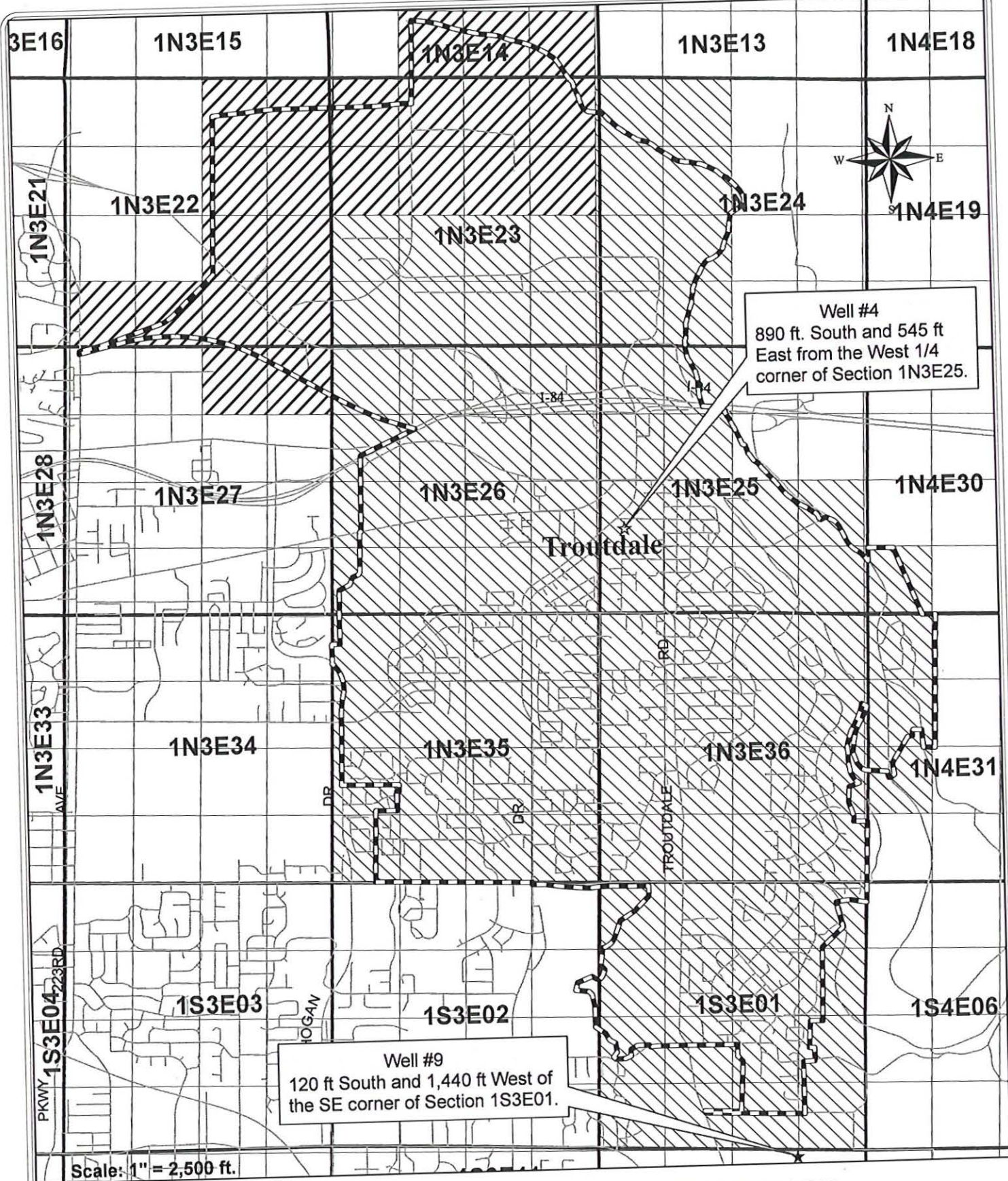
