- 4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 20, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. On January 17, 2008, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10337 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 6. On April 2, 2008, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-10337 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on April 8, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. The proposed point of appropriation (UMAT 1046) will develop the same source of water as the authorized existing well (UMAT 1050).
- 9. A well, pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of application T-10337.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

This would suggest that the pump is able to provide a higher pressure than the 50 psi shown as the pump operating pressure or maybe the pump efficiency is lower than the assumed 75%, either of which would reduce the pump flow slightly. The pump calculations indicate the pump is capable of delivering the flow of the sprinklers.







- 4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 20, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. On January 17, 2008, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10337 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. The proposed point of appropriation (UMAT 1046) will develop the same source of water as the authorized existing well (UMAT 1050).
- 8. A well, pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of application T-10337.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action
